Christ Died

But God demonstrates His own love toward us, in that while we were still sinners, Christ <u>died for</u> us. Romans 5:8

Die For

- 2 Chronicles 25:4 However he did not execute their children, but *did* as *it is* written in the Law in the Book of Moses, where the LORD commanded, saying, "The fathers shall not be put to death for their children, nor shall the children be put to death for their fathers; but a person shall <u>die for</u> his own sin."
- Proverbs 5:23 He shall die for lack of instruction, And in the greatness of his folly he shall go astray.
- Proverbs 10:21 The lips of the righteous feed many, But fools die for lack of wisdom.
- Jeremiah 31:30 But every one shall <u>die for</u> his own iniquity; every man who eats the sour grapes, his teeth shall be set on edge.
- Ezekiel 18:17 *Who* has withdrawn his hand from the poor *And* not received usury or increase, But has executed My judgments And walked in My statutes—He shall not <u>die for</u> the iniquity of his father; He shall surely live!
- Ezekiel 18:18 *As for* his father, Because he cruelly oppressed, Robbed his brother by violence, And did what *is* not good among his people, Behold, he shall <u>die for</u> his iniquity.
- John 11:50 Nor do you consider that it is expedient for us that one man should <u>die for</u> the people, and not that the whole nation should perish.
- John 18:14 Now it was Caiaphas who advised the Jews that it was expedient that one man should <u>die for</u> the people.

Died For

- 2 Samuel 3:27 Now when Abner had returned to Hebron, Joab took him aside in the gate to speak with him privately, and there stabbed him in the stomach, so that he <u>died for</u> the blood of Asahel his brother.
- 1 Chronicles 10:13 So Saul <u>died for</u> his unfaithfulness which he had committed against the LORD, because he did not keep the word of the LORD, and also because he consulted a medium for guidance.
- Romans 5:6 For when we were still without strength, in due time Christ died for the ungodly.

- Romans 5:8 But God demonstrates His own love toward us, in that while we were still sinners, Christ <u>died</u> <u>for</u> us.
- 1 Corinthians 15:3 For I delivered to you first of all that which I also received: that Christ <u>died for</u> our sins according to the Scriptures.
- 2 Corinthians 5:14 For the love of Christ compels us, because we judge thus: that if One <u>died for</u> all, then all died.
- 2 Corinthians 5:15 And He <u>died for</u> all, that those who live should live no longer for themselves, but for Him who <u>died for</u> them and rose again.
- 1 Thessalonians 5:10 Who died for us, that whether we wake or sleep, we should live together with Him.

Jesus Died

- Acts 25:19 But had some questions against him about their own religion and about a certain Jesus, who had died, whom Paul affirmed to be alive.
- Romans 5:6 For when we were still without strength, in due time Christ died for the ungodly.
- Romans 5:8 But God demonstrates His own love toward us, in that while we were still sinners, Christ <u>died</u> for us.
- Romans 5:15 But the free gift is not like the offense. For if by the one man's offense many <u>died</u>, much more the grace of God and the gift by the grace of the one Man, Jesus Christ, abounded to many.
- Romans 6:10 For the death that He died, He died to sin once for all; but the life that He lives, He lives to God.
- Romans 7:9 I was alive once without the law, but when the commandment came, sin revived and I died.
- Romans 8:34 Who *is* he who condemns? *It is* Christ who <u>died</u>, and furthermore is also risen, who is even at the right hand of God, who also makes intercession for us.
- Romans 14:9 For to this end Christ <u>died</u> and rose and lived again, that He might be Lord of both the dead and the living.
- Romans 14:15 Yet if your brother is grieved because of *your* food, you are no longer walking in love. Do not destroy with your food the one for whom Christ <u>died</u>.
- 1 Corinthians 8:11 And because of your knowledge shall the weak brother perish, for whom Christ died?
- 1 Corinthians 15:3 For I delivered to you first of all that which I also received: that Christ <u>died</u> for our sins according to the Scriptures.
- 2 Corinthians 5:14 For the love of Christ compels us, because we judge thus: that if One <u>died</u> for all, then all died.
- 2 Corinthians 5:15 And He <u>died</u> for all, that those who live should live no longer for themselves, but for Him who died for them and rose again.

- Galatians 2:21 I do not set aside the grace of God; for if righteousness *comes* through the law, then Christ <u>died</u> in vain.
- 1 Thessalonians 4:14 For if we believe that Jesus <u>died</u> and rose again, even so God will bring with Him those who sleep in Jesus.
- 1 Thessalonians 5:10 Who died for us, that whether we wake or sleep, we should live together with Him.

We Died

- Romans 6:2 Certainly not! How shall we who died to sin live any longer in it?
- Romans 6:7 For he who has died has been freed from sin.
- Romans 6:8 Now if we died with Christ, we believe that we shall also live with Him.
- Romans 7:6 But now we have been delivered from the law, having <u>died</u> to what we were held by, so that we should serve in the newness of the Spirit and not *in* the oldness of the letter.
- Galatians 2:19 For I through the law <u>died</u> to the law that I might live to God.
- Colossians 2:20 Therefore, if you <u>died</u> with Christ from the basic principles of the world, why, as *though* living in the world, do you subject yourselves to regulations.
- Colossians 3:3 For you died, and your life is hidden with Christ in God.
- 2 Timothy 2:11 This is a faithful saying: For if we died with Him, We shall also live with Him.
- Hebrews 11:13 These all <u>died</u> in faith, not having received the promises, but having seen them afar off were assured of them, embraced *them* and confessed that they were strangers and pilgrims on the earth.
- 1 Peter 2:24 Who Himself bore our sins in His own body on the tree, that we, having <u>died</u> to sins, might live for righteousness—by whose stripes you were healed.

Crucify

- Matthew 20:19 And deliver Him to the Gentiles to mock and to scourge and to <u>crucify</u>. And the third day He will rise again.
- Matthew 23:34 Therefore, indeed, I send you prophets, wise men, and scribes: *some* of them you will kill and <u>crucify</u>, and *some* of them you will scourge in your synagogues and persecute from city to city.
- Mark 15:13 So they cried out again, "Crucify Him!"
- Mark 15:14 Then Pilate said to them, "Why, what evil has He done?" But they cried out all the more, "Crucify Him!"

- Mark 15:20 And when they had mocked Him, they took the purple off Him, put His own clothes on Him, and led Him out to <u>crucify</u> Him.
- Luke 23:21 But they shouted, saying, "Crucify Him, crucify Him!"
- John 19:6 Therefore, when the chief priests and officers saw Him, they cried out, saying, "Crucify Him, crucify Him!" Pilate said to them, "You take Him and crucify Him, for I find no fault in Him."
- John 19:10 Then Pilate said to Him, "Are You not speaking to me? Do You not know that I have power to <u>crucify</u> You, and power to release You?"
- John 19:15 But they cried out, "Away with *Him*, away with *Him*! <u>Crucify</u> Him!" Pilate said to them, "Shall I <u>crucify</u> your King?" The chief priests answered, "We have no king but Caesar!"
- Hebrews 6:6 If they fall away, to renew them again to repentance, since they <u>crucify</u> again for themselves the Son of God, and put *Him* to an open shame.

Crucified

- Matthew 26:2 You know that after two days is the Passover, and the Son of Man will be delivered up to be crucified.
- Matthew 27:22 Pilate said to them, "What then shall I do with Jesus who is called Christ?" *They* all said to him, "Let Him be <u>crucified!"</u>
- Matthew 27:23 Then the governor said, "Why, what evil has He done?" But they cried out all the more, saying, "Let Him be <u>crucified!"</u>
- Matthew 27:26 Then he released Barabbas to them; and when he had scourged Jesus, he delivered *Him* to be crucified.
- Matthew 27:31 And when they had mocked Him, they took the robe off Him, put His *own* clothes on Him, and led Him away to be <u>crucified</u>.
- Matthew 27:35 Then they <u>crucified</u> Him, and divided His garments, casting lots, that it might be fulfilled which was spoken by the prophet: "They divided My garments among them, And for My clothing they cast lots."
- Matthew 27:38 Then two robbers were <u>crucified</u> with Him, one on the right and another on the left.
- Matthew 27:44 Even the robbers who were crucified with Him reviled Him with the same thing.
- Matthew 28:5 But the angel answered and said to the women, "Do not be afraid, for I know that you seek Jesus who was <u>crucified</u>.
- Mark 15:15 So Pilate, wanting to gratify the crowd, released Barabbas to them; and he delivered Jesus, after he had scourged *Him*, to be <u>crucified</u>.
- Mark 15:24 And when they <u>crucified</u> Him, they divided His garments, casting lots for them *to determine* what every man should take.

- Mark 15:25 Now it was the third hour, and they crucified Him.
- Mark 15:27 With Him they also crucified two robbers, one on His right and the other on His left.
- Mark 15:32 "Let the Christ, the King of Israel, descend now from the cross, that we may see and believe." Even those who were crucified with Him reviled Him.
- Mark 16:6 But he said to them, "Do not be alarmed. You seek Jesus of Nazareth, who was <u>crucified</u>. He is risen! He is not here. See the place where they laid Him.
- Luke 23:23 But they were insistent, demanding with loud voices that He be <u>crucified</u>. And the voices of these men and of the chief priests prevailed.
- Luke 23:33 And when they had come to the place called Calvary, there they <u>crucified</u> Him, and the criminals, one on the right hand and the other on the left.
- Luke 24:7 Saying, 'The Son of Man must be delivered into the hands of sinful men, and be <u>crucified</u>, and the third day rise again.'
- Luke 24:20 And how the chief priests and our rulers delivered Him to be condemned to death, and <u>crucified</u> Him.
- John 19:16 Then he delivered Him to them to be <u>crucified</u>. So they took Jesus and led *Him* away.
- John 19:18 where they <u>crucified</u> Him, and two others with Him, one on either side, and Jesus in the center.
- John 19:20 Then many of the Jews read this title, for the place where Jesus was <u>crucified</u> was near the city; and it was written in Hebrew, Greek, *and* Latin.
- John 19:23 Then the soldiers, when they had <u>crucified</u> Jesus, took His garments and made four parts, to each soldier a part, and also the tunic. Now the tunic was without seam, woven from the top in one piece.
- John 19:32 Then the soldiers came and broke the legs of the first and of the other who was <u>crucified</u> with Him.
- John 19:41 Now in the place where He was <u>crucified</u> there was a garden, and in the garden a new tomb in which no one had yet been laid.
- Acts 2:23 Him, being delivered by the determined purpose and foreknowledge of God, you have taken by lawless hands, have crucified, and put to death.
- Acts 2:36 Therefore let all the house of Israel know assuredly that God has made this Jesus, whom you <u>crucified</u>, both Lord and Christ.
- Acts 4:10 Let it be known to you all, and to all the people of Israel, that by the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth, whom you <u>crucified</u>, whom God raised from the dead, by Him this man stands here before you whole.
- Romans 6:6 Knowing this, that our old man was <u>crucified</u> with *Him*, that the body of sin might be done away with, that we should no longer be slaves of sin.

- 1 Corinthians 1:13 Is Christ divided? Was Paul crucified for you? Or were you baptized in the name of Paul?
- 1 Corinthians 1:23 But we preach Christ <u>crucified</u>, to the Jews a stumbling block and to the Greeks foolishness.
- 1 Corinthians 2:2 For I determined not to know anything among you except Jesus Christ and Him crucified.
- 1 Corinthians 2:8 which none of the rulers of this age knew; for had they known, they would not have <u>crucified</u> the Lord of glory.
- 2 Corinthians 13:4 For though He was <u>crucified</u> in weakness, yet He lives by the power of God. For we also are weak in Him, but we shall live with Him by the power of God toward you.
- Galatians 2:20 I have been <u>crucified</u> with Christ; it is no longer I who live, but Christ lives in me; and the *life* which I now live in the flesh I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave Himself for me.
- Galatians 3:1 O foolish Galatians! Who has bewitched you that you should not obey the truth, before whose eyes Jesus Christ was clearly portrayed among you as <u>crucified</u>?
- Galatians 5:24 And those who are Christ's have crucified the flesh with its passions and desires.
- Galatians 6:14 But God forbid that I should boast except in the cross of our Lord Jesus Christ, by whom the world has been <u>crucified</u> to me, and I to the world.
- Revelation 11:8 And their dead bodies *will lie* in the street of the great city which spiritually is called Sodom and Egypt, where also our Lord was <u>crucified</u>.

Death of the Cross

Philippians 2:8 And being found in appearance as a man, He humbled Himself and became obedient to *the point of death*, even the <u>death</u> of the <u>cross</u>.

Cross of Jesus/Christ

- John 19:25 Now there stood by the cross of Jesus His mother, and His mother's sister, Mary the *wife* of Clopas, and Mary Magdalene.
- 1 Corinthians 1:17 For Christ did not send me to baptize, but to preach the gospel, not with wisdom of words, lest the cross of Christ should be made of no effect.
- Galatians 6:12 As many as desire to make a good showing in the flesh, these *would* compel you to be circumcised, only that they may not suffer persecution for the cross of Christ.
- Galatians 6:14 But God forbid that I should boast except in the cross of our Lord Jesus Christ, by whom the world has been crucified to me, and I to the world.
- Philippians 3:18 For many walk, of whom I have told you often, and now tell you even weeping, *that they are* the enemies of <u>the cross</u> of Christ:

Colossians 2:14 having wiped out the handwriting of requirements that was against us, which was contrary to us. And He has taken it out of the way, having nailed it to the cross.
Hebrews 12:2 looking unto Jesus, the author and finisher of <i>our</i> faith, who for the joy that was set before Him endured <u>the cross</u> , despising the shame, and has sat down at the right hand of the throne of God.
