# **Reason Together**

Isaiah 1:18 "Come now, and let us <u>reason together</u>," Says the LORD, "Though your sins are like scarlet, They shall be as white as snow; Though they are red like crimson, They shall be as wool."

# **Reason With**

- 1 Samuel 12:7 Now therefore, stand still, that I may <u>reason with</u> you before the LORD concerning all the righteous acts of the LORD which He did to you and your fathers.
- Job 9:14 How then can I answer Him, And choose my words to reason with Him?
- Job 13:3 But I would speak to the Almighty, And I desire to reason with God.
- Job 15:3 Should he reason with unprofitable talk, Or by speeches with which he can do no good?
- Job 23:7 There the upright could reason with Him, And I would be delivered forever from my Judge.

# To Reason

- Job 9:14 How then can I answer Him, And choose my words to reason with Him?
- Job 13:3 But I would speak to the Almighty, And I desire to reason with God.
- Luke 5:21 And the scribes and the Pharisees began to reason, saying, "Who is this who speaks blasphemies? Who can forgive sins but God alone?"

# Reasoning

Job 13:6 Now hear my reasoning, And heed the pleadings of my lips.

Mark 2:6 And some of the scribes were sitting there and reasoning in their hearts.

- Mark 12:28 Then one of the scribes came, and having heard them <u>reasoning</u> together, perceiving that He had answered them well, asked Him, "Which is the first commandment of all?"
- Luke 5:22 But when Jesus perceived their thoughts, He answered and said to them, "Why are you <u>reasoning</u> in your hearts?"
- Acts 19:8 And he went into the synagogue and spoke boldly for three months, <u>reasoning</u> and persuading concerning the things of the kingdom of God.
- Acts 19:9 But when some were hardened and did not believe, but spoke evil of the Way before the multitude, he departed from them and withdrew the disciples, <u>reasoning</u> daily in the school of Tyrannus.

#### Debate

Proverbs 25:9 Debate your case with your neighbor, And do not disclose the secret to another;

Isaiah 58:4 Indeed you fast for strife and <u>debate</u>, And to strike with the fist of wickedness. You will not fast as *you do* this day, To make your voice heard on high.

# Contend

- Exodus 17:2 Therefore the people contended with Moses, and said, "Give us water, that we may drink." And Moses said to them, "Why do you <u>contend</u> with me? Why do you tempt the LORD?"
- Exodus 21:18 If men <u>contend</u> with each other, and one strikes the other with a stone or with *his* fist, and he does not die but is confined to *his* bed.
- Deuteronomy 2:9 Then the LORD said to me, 'Do not harass Moab, nor <u>contend</u> with them in battle, for I will not give you *any* of their land *as* a possession, because I have given Ar to the descendants of Lot *as* a possession.'
- Job 9:3 If one wished to contend with Him, He could not answer Him one time out of a thousand.
- Job 10:2 I will say to God, 'Do not condemn me; Show me why You contend with me.'
- Job 13:8 Will you show partiality for Him? Will you contend for God?
- Job 13:19 Who is he who will contend with me? If now I hold my tongue, I perish.

Job 23:6 Would He contend with me in His great power? No! But He would take note of me.

Job 33:13 Why do you <u>contend</u> with Him? For He does not give an accounting of any of His words.

- Proverbs 28:4 Those who forsake the law praise the wicked, But such as keep the law <u>contend</u> with them.
- Ecclesiastes 6:10 Whatever one is, he has been named already, For it is known that he *is* man; And he cannot <u>contend</u> with Him who is mightier than he.
- Isaiah 43:26 Put Me in remembrance; Let us <u>contend</u> together; State your *case*, that you may be acquitted.

- Psalms 119:154 Plead my cause and redeem me; Revive me according to Your word.

# **Plead His**

Proverbs 18:17 The first one to plead his cause seems right, Until his neighbor comes and examines him.

Jeremiah 25:31 A noise will come to the ends of the earth—For the LORD has a controversy with the nations; He will <u>plead His</u> case with all flesh. He will give those *who are* wicked to the sword,' says the LORD.

# **Plead Their**

- Proverbs 22:23 For the LORD will plead their cause, And plunder the soul of those who plunder them.
- Proverbs 23:11 For their Redeemer is mighty; He will plead their cause against you.
- Jeremiah 50:34 Their Redeemer *is* strong; The LORD of hosts *is* His name. He will thoroughly <u>plead their</u> case, That He may give rest to the land, And disquiet the inhabitants of Babylon.

#### Plead For the Needy

Proverbs 31:9 Open your mouth, judge righteously, And <u>plead</u> the cause of the poor and needy.

- Isaiah 1:17 Learn to do good; Seek justice, Rebuke the oppressor; Defend the fatherless, <u>Plead</u> for the widow.
- Jeremiah 5:28 They have grown fat, they are sleek; Yes, they surpass the deeds of the wicked; They do not <u>plead</u> the cause, The cause of the fatherless; Yet they prosper, And the right of the needy they do not defend.

# Plead With

- Proverbs 6:3 So do this, my son, and deliver yourself; For you have come into the hand of your friend: Go and humble yourself; <u>Plead with</u> your friend.
- Jeremiah 2:29 "Why will you plead with Me? You all have transgressed against Me," says the LORD.
- Jeremiah 12:1 Righteous *are* You, O LORD, when I <u>plead with</u> You; Yet let me talk with You about *Your* judgments. Why does the way of the wicked prosper? *Why* are those happy who deal so treacherously?

Mark 5:17 Then they began to plead with Him to depart from their region.

- 1 Corinthians 1:10 Now I <u>plead with</u> you, brethren, by the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, that you all speak the same thing, and *that* there be no divisions among you, but *that* you be perfectly joined together in the same mind and in the same judgment.
- 2 Corinthians 6:1 We then, *as* workers together *with Him* also <u>plead with</u> *you* not to receive the grace of God in vain.
- 2 John 1:5 And now I <u>plead with</u> you, lady, not as though I wrote a new commandment to you, but that which we have had from the beginning: that we love one another.

#### **Plead For**

- Judges 6:31 But Joash said to all who stood against him, "Would you <u>plead for</u> Baal? Would you save him? Let the one who would <u>plead for</u> him be put to death by morning! If he *is* a god, let him <u>plead for</u> himself, because his altar has been torn down!"
- Job 16:21 Oh, that one might plead for a man with God, As a man pleads for his neighbor!
- Isaiah 1:17 Learn to do good; Seek justice, Rebuke the oppressor; Defend the fatherless, <u>Plead for</u> the widow.
- Isaiah 59:4 No one calls for justice, Nor does *any* <u>plead</u> for truth. They trust in empty words and speak lies; They conceive evil and bring forth iniquity.

# **Plead Against**

Judges 6:32 Therefore on that day he called him Jerubbaal, saying, "Let Baal <u>plead</u> against him, because he has torn down his altar."

# Pleading

Esther 7:7 Then the king arose in his wrath from the banquet of wine *and went* into the palace garden; but Haman stood before Queen Esther, <u>pleading</u> for his life, for he saw that evil was determined against him by the king.

Matthew 8:5 Now when Jesus had entered Capernaum, a centurion came to Him, pleading with Him.

- Luke 7:3 So when he heard about Jesus, he sent elders of the Jews to Him, <u>pleading</u> with Him to come and heal his servant.
- Acts 19:31 Then some of the officials of Asia, who were his friends, sent to him <u>pleading</u> that he would not venture into the theater.
- 2 Corinthians 5:20 Now then, we are ambassadors for Christ, as though God were <u>pleading</u> through us: we implore *you* on Christ's behalf, be reconciled to God.
- 2 Corinthians 10:1 Now I, Paul, myself am <u>pleading</u> with you by the meekness and gentleness of Christ who in presence *am* lowly among you, but being absent am bold toward you.

# **Biblical Example of Pleading**

**Esther:** He also gave him a copy of the written decree for their destruction, which was given at Shushan, that he might show it to Esther and explain it to her, and that he might command her to go in to the king to make supplication to him and <u>plead</u> before him for her people. Esther 4:8

**Job:** Then Job answered and said: "Even today my complaint is bitter; My hand is listless because of my groaning. Oh, that I knew where I might find Him, *That* I might come to His seat! I would present *my* case before Him, And fill my mouth with arguments. I would know the words *which* He would answer me, And understand what He would say to me. Would He contend with me in His great power? No! But He would take *note* of me. There the upright could reason with Him, And I would be delivered forever from my Judge." Job 23:1-7

# Case

- Genesis 30:6 Then Rachel said, "God has judged my <u>case</u>; and He has also heard my voice and given me a son." Therefore she called his name Dan.
- Genesis 43:18 Now the men were afraid because they were brought into Joseph's house; and they said, "*It is* because of the money, which was returned in our sacks the first time, that we are brought in, so that he may make a <u>case</u> against us and fall upon us, to take us as slaves with our donkeys."
- Exodus 18:26 So they judged the people at all times; the hard cases they brought to Moses, but they judged every small <u>case</u> themselves.
- Numbers 27:5 So Moses brought their case before the LORD.
- Deuteronomy 1:17 'You shall not show partiality in judgment; you shall hear the small as well as the great; you shall not be afraid in any man's presence, for the judgment *is* God's. The <u>case</u> that is too hard for you, bring to me, and I will hear it.'
- Deuteronomy 19:4 And this *is* the <u>case</u> of the manslayer who flees there, that he may live: Whoever kills his neighbor unintentionally, not having hated him in time past—
- Deuteronomy 24:13 You shall in any <u>case</u> return the pledge to him again when the sun goes down, that he may sleep in his own garment and bless you; and it shall be righteousness to you before the LORD your God.

- Joshua 20:4 And when he flees to one of those cities, and stands at the entrance of the gate of the city, and declares his <u>case</u> in the hearing of the elders of that city, they shall take him into the city as one of them, and give him a place, that he may dwell among them.

- Jeremiah 20:12 But, O LORD of hosts, You who test the righteous, *And* see the mind and heart, Let me see Your vengeance on them; For I have pleaded <u>my cause</u> before You.

- 1 Kings 8:45 Then hear in heaven their prayer and their supplication, and maintain their cause.
- 1 Kings 8:49 Then hear in heaven Your dwelling place their prayer and their supplication, and maintain <u>their</u> <u>cause</u>,
- 2 Chronicles 6:35 Then hear from heaven their prayer and their supplication, and maintain their cause.
- 2 Chronicles 6:39 Then hear from heaven Your dwelling place their prayer and their supplications, and maintain <u>their cause</u>, and forgive Your people who have sinned against You.

Proverbs 22:23 For the LORD will plead their cause, And plunder the soul of those who plunder them.

Proverbs 23:11 For their Redeemer is mighty; He will plead their cause against you.
