Cross of Christ

But God forbid that I should boast except in the <u>cross</u> of our Lord Jesus Christ, by whom the world has been crucified to me, and I to the world. Galatians 6:14

- Matthew 10:38 And he who does not take his cross and follow after Me is not worthy of Me.
- Matthew 16:24 Then Jesus said to His disciples, "If anyone desires to come after Me, let him deny himself, and take up his cross, and follow Me."
- Matthew 27:32 Now as they came out, they found a man of Cyrene, Simon by name. Him they compelled to bear His cross.
- Matthew 27:40 And saying, "You who destroy the temple and build *it* in three days, save Yourself! If You are the Son of God, come down from the <u>cross</u>."
- Matthew 27:42 He saved others; Himself He cannot save. If He is the King of Israel, let Him now come down from the <u>cross</u>, and we will believe Him.
- Mark 8:34 When He had called the people to *Himself*, with His disciples also, He said to them, "Whoever desires to come after Me, let him deny himself, and take up his <u>cross</u>, and follow Me.
- Mark 10:21 Then Jesus, looking at him, loved him, and said to him, "One thing you lack: Go your way, sell whatever you have and give to the poor, and you will have treasure in heaven; and come, take up the cross, and follow Me."
- Mark 15:21 Then they compelled a certain man, Simon a Cyrenian, the father of Alexander and Rufus, as he was coming out of the country and passing by, to bear His <u>cross</u>.
- Mark 15:30 Save Yourself, and come down from the cross!
- Mark 15:32 "Let the Christ, the King of Israel, descend now from the <u>cross</u>, that we may see and believe." Even those who were crucified with Him reviled Him.
- Luke 9:23 Then He said to *them* all, "If anyone desires to come after Me, let him deny himself, and take up his <u>cross</u> daily, and follow Me."
- Luke 14:27 And whoever does not bear his cross and come after Me cannot be My disciple.
- Luke 23:26 Now as they led Him away, they laid hold of a certain man, Simon a Cyrenian, who was coming from the country, and on him they laid the cross that he might bear *it* after Jesus.
- John 19:17 And He, bearing His cross, went out to a place called *the Place* of a Skull, which is called in Hebrew, Golgotha.
- John 19:19 Now Pilate wrote a title and put *it* on the <u>cross</u>. And the writing was: JESUS OF NAZARETH, THE KING OF THE JEWS.

- John 19:25 Now there stood by the <u>cross</u> of Jesus His mother, and His mother's sister, Mary the *wife* of Clopas, and Mary Magdalene.
- John 19:31 Therefore, because it was the Preparation *Day*, that the bodies should not remain on the <u>cross</u> on the Sabbath (for that Sabbath was a high day), the Jews asked Pilate that their legs might be broken, and *that* they might be taken away.
- 1 Corinthians 1:17 For Christ did not send me to baptize, but to preach the gospel, not with wisdom of words, lest the <u>cross</u> of Christ should be made of no effect.
- 1 Corinthians 1:18 For the message of the <u>cross</u> is foolishness to those who are perishing, but to us who are being saved it is the power of God.
- Galatians 5:11 And I, brethren, if I still preach circumcision, why do I still suffer persecution? Then the offense of the <u>cross</u> has ceased.
- Galatians 6:12 As many as desire to make a good showing in the flesh, these *would* compel you to be circumcised, only that they may not suffer persecution for the <u>cross</u> of Christ.
- Galatians 6:14 But God forbid that I should boast except in the <u>cross</u> of our Lord Jesus Christ, by whom the world has been crucified to me, and I to the world.
- Ephesians 2:16 And that He might reconcile them both to God in one body through the <u>cross</u>, thereby putting to death the enmity.
- Philippians 2:8 And being found in appearance as a man, He humbled Himself and became obedient to *the point of* death, even the death of the <u>cross</u>.
- Philippians 3:18 For many walk, of whom I have told you often, and now tell you even weeping, *that they are* the enemies of the <u>cross</u> of Christ:
- Colossians 1:20 And by Him to reconcile all things to Himself, by Him, whether things on earth or things in heaven, having made peace through the blood of His <u>cross</u>.
- Colossians 2:14 Having wiped out the handwriting of requirements that was against us, which was contrary to us. And He has taken it out of the way, having nailed it to the <u>cross</u>.
- Hebrews 12:2 Looking unto Jesus, the author and finisher of *our* faith, who for the joy that was set before Him endured the <u>cross</u>, despising the shame, and has sat down at the right hand of the throne of God.
