## Heaven and Earth

- Genesis 14:19 And he blessed him and said: "Blessed be Abram of God Most High, Possessor of heaven and earth."
- Genesis 14:22 But Abram said to the king of Sodom, "I have raised my hand to the LORD, God Most High, the Possessor of <u>heaven and earth</u>.
- Deuteronomy 4:26 I call <u>heaven and earth</u> to witness against you this day, that you will soon utterly perish from the land which you cross over the Jordan to possess; you will not prolong *your* days in it, but will be utterly destroyed.
- Deuteronomy 30:19 I call <u>heaven and earth</u> as witnesses today against you, *that* I have set before you life and death, blessing and cursing; therefore choose life, that both you and your descendants may live;
- Deuteronomy 31:28 Gather to me all the elders of your tribes, and your officers, that I may speak these words in their hearing and call <u>heaven and earth</u> to witness against them.
- 2 Samuel 18:9 Then Absalom met the servants of David. Absalom rode on a mule. The mule went under the thick boughs of a great terebinth tree, and his head caught in the terebinth; so he was left hanging between <u>heaven and earth</u>. And the mule which *was* under him went on.
- 2 Kings 19:15 Then Hezekiah prayed before the LORD, and said: "O LORD God of Israel, *the One* who dwells *between* the cherubim, You are God, You alone, of all the kingdoms of the earth. You have made <u>heaven and earth</u>.
- 2 Chronicles 2:12 Hiram also said: Blessed *be* the LORD God of Israel, who made <u>heaven and earth</u>, for He has given King David a wise son, endowed with prudence and understanding, who will build a temple for the LORD and a royal house for himself!
- Ezra 5:11 And thus they returned us an answer, saying: "We are the servants of the God of <u>heaven and earth</u>, and we are rebuilding the temple that was built many years ago, which a great king of Israel built and completed.

Psalms 69:34 Let heaven and earth praise Him, The seas and everything that moves in them.

Psalms 115:15 May you be blessed by the LORD, Who made heaven and earth.

Psalms 121:2 My help comes from the LORD, Who made heaven and earth.

Psalms 124:8 Our help is in the name of the LORD, Who made heaven and earth.

Psalms 134:3 The LORD who made heaven and earth Bless you from Zion!

- Psalms 146:6 Who made heaven and earth, The sea, and all that is in them; Who keeps truth forever,
- Isaiah 37:16 O LORD of hosts, God of Israel, *the One* who dwells *between* the cherubim, You *are* God, You alone, of all the kingdoms of the earth. You have made <u>heaven and earth</u>.
- Jeremiah 23:24 "Can anyone hide himself in secret places, So I shall not see him?" says the LORD; "Do I not fill <u>heaven and earth</u>?" says the LORD.
- Jeremiah 33:25 Thus says the LORD: 'If My covenant *is* not with day and night, *and if* I have not appointed the ordinances of <u>heaven and earth</u>.'
- Haggai 2:6 For thus says the LORD of hosts: 'Once more (it *is* a little while) I will shake <u>heaven and earth</u>, the sea and dry land.'
- Haggai 2:21 Speak to Zerubbabel, governor of Judah, saying: I will shake heaven and earth.'
- Matthew 5:18 For assuredly, I say to you, till <u>heaven and earth</u> pass away, one jot or one tittle will by no means pass from the law till all is fulfilled.
- Matthew 11:25 At that time Jesus answered and said, "I thank You, Father, Lord of <u>heaven and earth</u>, that You have hidden these things from *the* wise and prudent and have revealed them to babes."

Matthew 24:35 Heaven and earth will pass away, but My words will by no means pass away.

- Mark 13:31 Heaven and earth will pass away, but My words will by no means pass away.
- Luke 10:21 In that hour Jesus rejoiced in the Spirit and said, "I thank You, Father, Lord of <u>heaven and earth</u>, that You have hidden these things from *the* wise and prudent and revealed them to babes. Even so, Father, for so it seemed good in Your sight."
- Luke 16:17 And it is easier for heaven and earth to pass away than for one tittle of the law to fail.
- Luke 21:33 Heaven and earth will pass away, but My words will by no means pass away.
- Acts 4:24 So when they heard that, they raised their voice to God with one accord and said: "Lord, You *are* God, who made <u>heaven and earth</u> and the sea, and all that is in them"
- Acts 17:24 God, who made the world and everything in it, since He is Lord of <u>heaven and earth</u>, does not dwell in temples made with hands.
- Ephesians 3:15 From whom the whole family in heaven and earth is named.
- Revelation 14:7 Saying with a loud voice, "Fear God and give glory to Him, for the hour of His judgment has come; and worship Him who made <u>heaven and earth</u>, the sea and springs of water."

#### Earth and Heaven

- 1 Chronicles 21:16 Then David lifted his eyes and saw the angel of the LORD standing between <u>earth and heaven</u>, having in his hand a drawn sword stretched out over Jerusalem. So David and the elders, clothed in sackcloth, fell on their faces.
- Psalms 148:13 Let them praise the name of the LORD, For His name alone is exalted; His glory *is* above the <u>earth and heaven</u>.
- Ezekiel 8:3 He stretched out the form of a hand, and took me by a lock of my hair; and the Spirit lifted me up between <u>earth and heaven</u>, and brought me in visions of God to Jerusalem, to the door of the north gate of the inner *court*, where the seat of the image of jealousy *was*, which provokes to jealousy.
- Zechariah 5:9 Then I raised my eyes and looked, and there *were* two women, coming with the wind in their wings; for they had wings like the wings of a stork, and they lifted up the basket between <u>earth and heaven</u>.

## Heaven, Earth

- Genesis 6:17 And behold, I Myself am bringing floodwaters on the <u>earth</u>, to destroy from under <u>heaven</u> all flesh in which *is* the breath of life; everything that *is* on the <u>earth</u> shall die.
- Genesis 7:19 And the waters prevailed exceedingly on the <u>earth</u>, and all the high hills under the whole <u>heaven</u> were covered.
- Genesis 24:3 And I will make you swear by the LORD, the God of <u>heaven</u> and the God of the <u>earth</u>, that you will not take a wife for my son from the daughters of the Canaanites, among whom I dwell;
- Genesis 26:4 And I will make your descendants multiply as the stars of <u>heaven</u>; I will give to your descendants all these lands; and in your seed all the nations of the <u>earth</u> shall be blessed.
- Genesis 27:28 Therefore may God give you Of the dew of <u>heaven</u>, Of the fatness of the <u>earth</u>, And plenty of grain and wine.
- Genesis 27:39 Then Isaac his father answered and said to him: "Behold, your dwelling shall be of the fatness of the <u>earth</u>, And of the dew of <u>heaven</u> from above."
- Genesis 28:12 Then he dreamed, and behold, a ladder *was* set up on the <u>earth</u>, and its top reached to <u>heaven</u>; and there the angels of God were ascending and descending on it.
- Exodus 20:4 You shall not make for yourself a carved image, or any likeness *of anything* that *is* in <u>heaven</u> above, or that *is* in the <u>earth</u> beneath, or that *is* in the water under the <u>earth</u>.
- Deuteronomy 3:24 'O Lord GOD, You have begun to show Your servant Your greatness and Your mighty hand, for what god *is there* in <u>heaven</u> or on <u>earth</u> who can do *anything* like Your works and Your mighty *deeds*?
- Deuteronomy 4:32 For ask now concerning the days that are past, which were before you, since the day that God created man on the <u>earth</u>, and *ask* from one end of <u>heaven</u> to the other, whether *any* great *thing* like this has happened, or *anything* like it has been heard.

- Deuteronomy 4:36 Out of <u>heaven</u> He let you hear His voice, that He might instruct you; on <u>earth</u> He showed you His great fire, and you heard His words out of the midst of the fire.
- Deuteronomy 4:39 Therefore know this day, and consider *it* in your heart, that the LORD Himself *is* God in <u>heaven</u> above and on the <u>earth</u> beneath; *there is* no other.
- Deuteronomy 5:8 You shall not make for yourself a carved image—any likeness *of anything* that *is* in <u>heaven</u> above, or that *is* in the <u>earth</u> beneath, or that *is* in the water under the <u>earth</u>.
- Deuteronomy 10:14 Indeed <u>heaven</u> and the highest heavens belong to the LORD your God, *also* the <u>earth</u> with all that *is* in it.
- Joshua 2:11 And as soon as we heard *these things*, our hearts melted; neither did there remain any more courage in anyone because of you, for the LORD your God, He *is* God in <u>heaven</u> above and on <u>earth</u> beneath.
- 1 Samuel 2:10 The adversaries of the LORD shall be broken in pieces; From <u>heaven</u> He will thunder against them. The LORD will judge the ends of the <u>earth</u>. "He will give strength to His king, And exalt the horn of His anointed."
- 2 Samuel 22:8 Then the <u>earth</u> shook and trembled; The foundations of <u>heaven</u> quaked and were shaken, Because He was angry.
- 1 Kings 8:23 And he said: "LORD God of Israel, *there is* no God in <u>heaven</u> above or on <u>earth</u> below like You, who keep *Your* covenant and mercy with Your servants who walk before You with all their hearts."
- 1 Kings 8:27 But will God indeed dwell on the <u>earth</u>? Behold, <u>heaven</u> and the <u>heaven</u> of heavens cannot contain You. How much less this temple which I have built!
- 1 Kings 8:43 Hear in <u>heaven</u> Your dwelling place, and do according to all for which the foreigner calls to You, that all peoples of the <u>earth</u> may know Your name and fear You, as *do* Your people Israel, and that they may know that this temple which I have built is called by Your name.
- 1 Chronicles 29:11 Yours, O LORD, *is* the greatness, The power and the glory, The victory and the majesty; For all *that is* in <u>heaven</u> and in <u>earth</u> *is Yours*; Yours *is* the kingdom, O LORD, And You are exalted as head over all.
- 2 Chronicles 6:14 And he said: "LORD God of Israel, *there is* no God in <u>heaven</u> or on <u>earth</u> like You, who keep *Your* covenant and mercy with Your servants who walk before You with all their hearts."
- 2 Chronicles 6:18 But will God indeed dwell with men on the <u>earth</u>? Behold, <u>heaven</u> and the <u>heaven</u> of heavens cannot contain You. How much less this temple which I have built!
- 2 Chronicles 6:33 Then hear from <u>heaven</u> Your dwelling place, and do according to all for which the foreigner calls to You, that all peoples of the <u>earth</u> may know Your name and fear You, as *do* Your people Israel, and that they may know that this temple which I have built is called by Your name.
- 2 Chronicles 36:23 Thus says Cyrus king of Persia: All the kingdoms of the <u>earth</u> the LORD God of <u>heaven</u> has given me. And He has commanded me to build Him a house at Jerusalem which is in Judah. Who *is* among you of all His people? May the LORD his God *be* with him, and let him go up!

- Ezra 1:2 Thus says Cyrus king of Persia: All the kingdoms of the <u>earth</u> the LORD God of <u>heaven</u> has given me. And He has commanded me to build Him a house at Jerusalem which *is* in Judah.
- Nehemiah 9:6 You alone *are* the LORD; You have made <u>heaven</u>, The <u>heaven</u> of heavens, with all their host, The <u>earth</u> and everything on it, The seas and all that is in them, And You preserve them all. The host of <u>heaven</u> worships You.
- Job 35:11 Who teaches us more than the beasts of the earth, And makes us wiser than the birds of heaven?"
- Job 37:3 He sends it forth under the whole heaven, His lightning to the ends of the earth.
- Psalms 73:25 Whom have I in heaven but You? And there is none upon earth that I desire besides You.
- Psalms 76:8 You caused judgment to be heard from heaven; The earth feared and was still.
- Psalms 85:11 Truth shall spring out of the earth, And righteousness shall look down from heaven.
- Psalms 102:19 For He looked down from the height of His sanctuary; From <u>heaven</u> the LORD viewed the <u>earth</u>.
- Psalms 115:16 The heaven, even the heavens, are the LORD'S; But the earth He has given to the children of men.
- Psalms 124:8 Our help is in the name of the LORD, Who made heaven and earth.
- Psalms 135:6 Whatever the LORD pleases He does, In <u>heaven</u> and in <u>earth</u>, In the seas and in all deep places.
- Psalms 146:6 Who made heaven and earth, The sea, and all that is in them; Who keeps truth forever.
- Proverbs 30:4 Who has ascended into <u>heaven</u>, or descended? Who has gathered the wind in His fists? Who has bound the waters in a garment? Who has established all the ends of the <u>earth</u>? What *is* His name, and what *is* His Son's name, If you know?
- Ecclesiastes 5:2 Do not be rash with your mouth, And let not your heart utter anything hastily before God. For God *is* in <u>heaven</u>, and you on <u>earth</u>; Therefore let your words be few.
- Isaiah 40:12 Who has measured the waters in the hollow of His hand, Measured <u>heaven</u> with a span And calculated the dust of the <u>earth</u> in a measure? Weighed the mountains in scales And the hills in a balance?
- Isaiah 55:10 For as the rain comes down, and the snow from <u>heaven</u>, And do not return there, But water the <u>earth</u>, And make it bring forth and bud, That it may give seed to the sower And bread to the eater.
- Isaiah 66:1 Thus says the LORD: "<u>Heaven</u> *is* My throne, And <u>earth</u> *is* My footstool. Where *is* the house that you will build Me? And where *is* the place of My rest?"
- Jeremiah 7:33 The corpses of this people will be food for the birds of the <u>heaven</u> and for the beasts of the <u>earth</u>. And no one will frighten *them away*.
- Jeremiah 8:2 They shall spread them before the sun and the moon and all the host of <u>heaven</u>, which they have loved and which they have served and after which they have walked, which they have sought and

which they have worshiped. They shall not be gathered nor buried; they shall be like refuse on the face of the <u>earth</u>.

- Jeremiah 16:4 They shall die gruesome deaths; they shall not be lamented nor shall they be buried, *but* they shall be like refuse on the face of the <u>earth</u>. They shall be consumed by the sword and by famine, and their corpses shall be meat for the birds of <u>heaven</u> and for the beasts of the <u>earth</u>.
- Jeremiah 19:7 And I will make void the counsel of Judah and Jerusalem in this place, and I will cause them to fall by the sword before their enemies and by the hands of those who seek their lives; their corpses I will give as meat for the birds of the <u>heaven</u> and for the beasts of the <u>earth</u>.
- Jeremiah 31:37 Thus says the LORD: "If <u>heaven</u> above can be measured, And the foundations of the <u>earth</u> searched out beneath, I will also cast off all the seed of Israel For all that they have done, says the LORD."
- Jeremiah 34:20 'I will give them into the hand of their enemies and into the hand of those who seek their life. Their dead bodies shall be for meat for the birds of the <u>heaven</u> and the beasts of the <u>earth</u>.'
- Jeremiah 51:15 He has made the <u>earth</u> by His power; He has established the world by His wisdom, And stretched out the <u>heaven</u> by His understanding.
- Lamentations 2:1 How the Lord has covered the daughter of Zion With a cloud in His anger! He cast down from <u>heaven</u> to the <u>earth</u> The beauty of Israel, And did not remember His footstool In the day of His anger.
- Daniel 4:15 Nevertheless leave the stump and roots in the <u>earth</u>, *Bound* with a band of iron and bronze, In the tender grass of the field. Let it be wet with the dew of <u>heaven</u>, And *let* him graze with the beasts On the grass of the <u>earth</u>.
- Daniel 4:23 And inasmuch as the king saw a watcher, a holy one, coming down from <u>heaven</u> and saying, 'Chop down the tree and destroy it, but leave its stump and roots in the <u>earth</u>, *bound* with a band of iron and bronze in the tender grass of the field; let it be wet with the dew of <u>heaven</u>, and let him graze with the beasts of the field, till seven times pass over him'.
- Daniel 4:35 All the inhabitants of the <u>earth</u> *are* reputed as nothing; He does according to His will in the army of <u>heaven</u> And *among* the inhabitants of the <u>earth</u>. No one can restrain His hand Or say to Him, "What have You done?"
- Daniel 6:27 He delivers and rescues, And He works signs and wonders In <u>heaven</u> and on <u>earth</u>, Who has delivered Daniel from the power of the lions.
- Zechariah 6:5 And the angel answered and said to me, "These *are* four spirits of <u>heaven</u>, who go out from *their* station before the Lord of all the <u>earth</u>.
- Matthew 5:18 For assuredly, I say to you, till <u>heaven</u> and <u>earth</u> pass away, one jot or one tittle will by no means pass from the law till all is fulfilled.
- Matthew 6:10 Your kingdom come. Your will be done On earth as it is in heaven.
- Matthew 16:19 And I will give you the keys of the kingdom of <u>heaven</u>, and whatever you bind on <u>earth</u> will be bound in <u>heaven</u>, and whatever you loose on <u>earth</u> will be loosed in <u>heaven</u>.

- Matthew 18:18 Assuredly, I say to you, whatever you bind on <u>earth</u> will be bound in <u>heaven</u>, and whatever you loose on <u>earth</u> will be loosed in <u>heaven</u>.
- Matthew 18:19 Again I say to you that if two of you agree on <u>earth</u> concerning anything that they ask, it will be done for them by My Father in <u>heaven</u>.
- Matthew 23:9 Do not call anyone on earth your father; for One is your Father, He who is in heaven.
- Matthew 24:30 Then the sign of the Son of Man will appear in <u>heaven</u>, and then all the tribes of the <u>earth</u> will mourn, and they will see the Son of Man coming on the clouds of <u>heaven</u> with power and great glory.
- Matthew 28:18 And Jesus came and spoke to them, saying, "All authority has been given to Me in <u>heaven</u> and on <u>earth</u>.
- Mark 13:27 And then He will send His angels, and gather together His elect from the four winds, from the farthest part of <u>earth</u> to the farthest part of <u>heaven</u>.
- Luke 11:2 So He said to them, "When you pray, say: Our Father in <u>heaven</u>, Hallowed be Your name. Your kingdom come. Your will be done On <u>earth</u> as *it is* in <u>heaven</u>."
- Luke 21:26 Men's hearts failing them from fear and the expectation of those things which are coming on the <u>earth</u>, for the powers of <u>heaven</u> will be shaken.
- John 3:31 He who comes from above is above all; he who is of the <u>earth</u> is earthly and speaks of the <u>earth</u>. He who comes from <u>heaven</u> is above all.
- Acts 2:19 I will show wonders in <u>heaven</u> above And signs in the <u>earth</u> beneath: Blood and fire and vapor of smoke.
- Acts 7:49 <u>Heaven</u> *is* My throne, And <u>earth</u> *is* My footstool. What house will you build for Me? says the LORD, Or what *is* the place of My rest?
- Acts 10:11 And saw <u>heaven</u> opened and an object like a great sheet bound at the four corners, descending to him and let down to the <u>earth</u>.
- Acts 14:15 And saying, "Men, why are you doing these things? We also are men with the same nature as you, and preach to you that you should turn from these useless things to the living God, who made the <u>heaven</u>, the <u>earth</u>, the sea, and all things that are in them."
- 1 Corinthians 8:5 For even if there are so-called gods, whether in <u>heaven</u> or on <u>earth</u> (as there are many gods and many lords).
- 1 Corinthians 15:47 The first man was of the earth, made of dust; the second Man is the Lord from heaven.
- Ephesians 1:10 That in the dispensation of the fullness of the times He might gather together in one all things in Christ, both which are in <u>heaven</u> and which are on <u>earth</u>—in Him.
- Philippians 2:10 That at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, of those in <u>heaven</u>, and of those on <u>earth</u>, and of those under the <u>earth</u>.

- Colossians 1:16 For by Him all things were created that are in <u>heaven</u> and that are on <u>earth</u>, visible and invisible, whether thrones or dominions or principalities or powers. All things were created through Him and for Him.
- Colossians 1:20 And by Him to reconcile all things to Himself, by Him, whether things on <u>earth</u> or things in <u>heaven</u>, having made peace through the blood of His cross.
- Hebrews 12:25 See that you do not refuse Him who speaks. For if they did not escape who refused Him who spoke on <u>earth</u>, much more *shall we not escape* if we turn away from Him who *speaks* from <u>heaven</u>.
- Hebrews 12:26 whose voice then shook the <u>earth</u>; but now He has promised, saying, "Yet once more I shake not only the <u>earth</u>, but also <u>heaven</u>."
- James 5:12 But above all, my brethren, do not swear, either by <u>heaven</u> or by <u>earth</u> or with any other oath. But let your "Yes," be "Yes," and *your* "No," "No," lest you fall into judgment.
- James 5:18 And he prayed again, and the heaven gave rain, and the earth produced its fruit.
- Revelation 5:3 And no one in <u>heaven</u> or on the <u>earth</u> or under the <u>earth</u> was able to open the scroll, or to look at it.
- Revelation 5:13 And every creature which is in <u>heaven</u> and on the <u>earth</u> and under the <u>earth</u> and such as are in the sea, and all that are in them, I heard saying: "Blessing and honor and glory and power *Be* to Him who sits on the throne, And to the Lamb, forever and ever!"

#### Heavens, Earth

Genesis 1:1 In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth.

- Genesis 1:15 And let them be for lights in the firmament of the <u>heavens</u> to give light on the <u>earth</u> and it was so.
- Genesis 1:17 God set them in the firmament of the heavens to give light on the earth.
- Genesis 1:20 Then God said, "Let the waters abound with an abundance of living creatures, and let birds fly above the <u>earth</u> across the face of the firmament of the <u>heavens</u>."
- Genesis 2:1 Thus the heavens and the earth, and all the host of them, were finished.
- Genesis 2:4 This *is* the history of the <u>heavens</u> and the <u>earth</u> when they were created, in the day that the LORD God made the <u>earth</u> and the <u>heavens</u>.
- Genesis 11:4 And they said, "Come, let us build ourselves a city, and a tower whose top *is* in the <u>heavens</u>; let us make a name for ourselves, lest we be scattered abroad over the face of the whole <u>earth</u>."
- Exodus 20:11 For *in* six days the LORD made the <u>heavens</u> and the <u>earth</u>, the sea, and all that *is* in them, and rested the seventh day. Therefore the LORD blessed the Sabbath day and hallowed it.
- Exodus 31:17 It *is* a sign between Me and the children of Israel forever; for *in* six days the LORD made the <u>heavens</u> and the <u>earth</u>, and on the seventh day He rested and was refreshed.

- Leviticus 26:19 I will break the pride of your power; I will make your <u>heavens</u> like iron and your <u>earth</u> like bronze.
- Deuteronomy 10:14 Indeed heaven and the highest <u>heavens</u> belong to the LORD your God, *also* the <u>earth</u> with all that *is* in it.
- Deuteronomy 11:21 That your days and the days of your children may be multiplied in the land of which the LORD swore to your fathers to give them, like the days of the <u>heavens</u> above the <u>earth</u>.
- Deuteronomy 28:23 And your <u>heavens</u> which *are* over your head shall be bronze, and the <u>earth</u> which is under you *shall be* iron.
- Deuteronomy 32:1 Give ear, O heavens, and I will speak; And hear, O earth, the words of my mouth.
- Judges 5:4 LORD, when You went out from Seir, When You marched from the field of Edom, The <u>earth</u> trembled and the <u>heavens</u> poured, The clouds also poured water.
- 1 Kings 8:27 But will God indeed dwell on the <u>earth</u>? Behold, heaven and the heaven of <u>heavens</u> cannot contain You. How much less this temple which I have built!
- 1 Chronicles 16:31 Let the <u>heavens</u> rejoice, and let the <u>earth</u> be glad; And let them say among the nations, "The LORD reigns."
- 2 Chronicles 6:18 But will God indeed dwell with men on the <u>earth</u>? Behold, heaven and the heaven of <u>heavens</u> cannot contain You. How much less this temple which I have built!
- Nehemiah 9:6 You alone *are* the LORD; You have made heaven, The heaven of <u>heavens</u>, with all their host, The <u>earth</u> and everything on it, The seas and all that is in them, And You preserve them all. The host of heaven worships You.
- Job 20:27 The heavens will reveal his iniquity, And the earth will rise up against him.
- Job 28:24 For He looks to the ends of the earth, And sees under the whole heavens.
- Job 38:33 Do you know the ordinances of the heavens? Can you set their dominion over the earth?
- Psalms 8:1 To the Chief Musician. On the instrument of Gath. A Psalm of David. O LORD, our Lord, How excellent *is* Your name in all the <u>earth</u>, Who have set Your glory above the <u>heavens</u>!

- Isaiah 64:1 Oh, that You would rend the <u>heavens</u>! That You would come down! That the mountains might shake at Your presence—
- Isaiah 65:17 For behold, I create new <u>heavens</u> and a new earth; And the former shall not be remembered or come to mind.

- Isaiah 66:22 "For as the new <u>heavens</u> and the new earth Which I will make shall remain before Me," says the LORD, "So shall your descendants and your name remain."
- Jeremiah 2:12 "Be astonished, O heavens, at this, And be horribly afraid; Be very desolate," says the LORD.
- Jeremiah 4:23 I beheld the earth, and indeed *it was* without form, and void; And the <u>heavens</u>, they *had* no light.
- Jeremiah 4:25 I beheld, and indeed there was no man, And all the birds of the heavens had fled.
- Jeremiah 4:28 For this shall the earth mourn, And the <u>heavens</u> above be black, Because I have spoken. I have purposed and will not relent, Nor will I turn back from it.
- Jeremiah 4:23 I beheld the earth, and indeed *it was* without form, and void; And the <u>heavens</u>, they *had* no light.
- Jeremiah 4:25 I beheld, and indeed there was no man, And all the birds of the heavens had fled.
- Jeremiah 4:28 For this shall the earth mourn, And the <u>heavens</u> above be black, Because I have spoken. I have purposed and will not relent, Nor will I turn back from it.
- Jeremiah 8:7 Even the stork in the <u>heavens</u> Knows her appointed times; And the turtledove, the swift, and the swallow Observe the time of their coming. But My people do not know the judgment of the LORD.
- Jeremiah 9:10 I will take up a weeping and wailing for the mountains, And for the dwelling places of the wilderness a lamentation, Because they are burned up, So that no one can pass through; Nor can *men* hear the voice of the cattle. Both the birds of the <u>heavens</u> and the beasts have fled; They are gone.
- Jeremiah 10:11 Thus you shall say to them: "The gods that have not made the <u>heavens</u> and the earth shall perish from the earth and from under these <u>heavens</u>."
- Jeremiah 10:12 He has made the earth by His power, He has established the world by His wisdom, And has stretched out the <u>heavens</u> at His discretion.
- Jeremiah 10:13 When He utters His voice, *There is* a multitude of waters in the <u>heavens</u>: "And He causes the vapors to ascend from the ends of the earth. He makes lightning for the rain, He brings the wind out of His treasuries."
- Jeremiah 14:22 Are there any among the idols of the nations that can cause rain? Or can the <u>heavens</u> give showers? *Are* You not He, O LORD our God? Therefore we will wait for You, Since You have made all these.
- Jeremiah 15:3 "And I will appoint over them four forms *of destruction*," says the LORD: "the sword to slay, the dogs to drag, the birds of the <u>heavens</u> and the beasts of the earth to devour and destroy.
- Jeremiah 32:17 Ah, Lord GOD! Behold, You have made the <u>heavens</u> and the earth by Your great power and outstretched arm. There is nothing too hard for You.
- Jeremiah 51:16 When He utters *His* voice—*There is* a multitude of waters in the <u>heavens</u>: "He causes the vapors to ascend from the ends of the earth; He makes lightnings for the rain; He brings the wind out of His treasuries.

- Jeremiah 51:48 "Then the <u>heavens</u> and the earth and all that *is* in them Shall sing joyously over Babylon; For the plunderers shall come to her from the north," says the LORD.
- Lamentations 3:66 In Your anger, Pursue and destroy them From under the heavens of the LORD.
- Lamentations 4:19 Our pursuers were swifter Than the eagles of the <u>heavens</u>. They pursued us on the mountains And lay in wait for us in the wilderness.
- Ezekiel 1:1 Now it came to pass in the thirtieth year, in the fourth *month*, on the fifth *day* of the month, as I *was* among the captives by the River Chebar, *that* the <u>heavens</u> were opened and I saw visions of God.
- Ezekiel 29:5 I will leave you in the wilderness, You and all the fish of your rivers; You shall fall on the open field; You shall not be picked up or gathered. I have given you as food To the beasts of the field And to the birds of the <u>heavens</u>.
- Ezekiel 31:6 All the birds of the <u>heavens</u> made their nests in its boughs; Under its branches all the beasts of the field brought forth their young; And in its shadow all great nations made their home.
- Ezekiel 31:13 On its ruin will remain all the birds of the <u>heavens</u>, And all the beasts of the field will come to its branches—
- Ezekiel 32:4 Then I will leave you on the land; I will cast you out on the open fields, And cause to settle on you all the birds of the <u>heavens</u>. And with you I will fill the beasts of the whole earth.
- Ezekiel 32:7 When *I* put out your light, I will cover the <u>heavens</u>, and make its stars dark; I will cover the sun with a cloud, And the moon shall not give her light.
- Ezekiel 32:8 'All the bright lights of the <u>heavens</u> I will make dark over you, And bring darkness upon your land,' Says the Lord GOD.
- Ezekiel 38:20 'So that the fish of the sea, the birds of the <u>heavens</u>, the beasts of the field, all creeping things that creep on the earth, and all men who *are* on the face of the earth shall shake at My presence. The mountains shall be thrown down, the steep places shall fall, and every wall shall fall to the ground.'
- Daniel 4:11 The tree grew and became strong; Its height reached to the <u>heavens</u>, And it could be seen to the ends of all the earth.
- Daniel 4:12 Its leaves *were* lovely, Its fruit abundant, And in it *was* food for all. The beasts of the field found shade under it, The birds of the <u>heavens</u> dwelt in its branches, And all flesh was fed from it.
- Daniel 4:20 The tree that you saw, which grew and became strong, whose height reached to the <u>heavens</u> and which *could be* seen by all the earth.
- Daniel 4:22 it *is* you, O king, who have grown and become strong; for your greatness has grown and reaches to the <u>heavens</u>, and your dominion to the end of the earth.
- Hosea 2:21 "It shall come to pass in that day *That* I will answer," says the LORD; "I will answer the <u>heavens</u>, And they shall answer the earth.
- Joel 2:10 The earth quakes before them, The <u>heavens</u> tremble; The sun and moon grow dark, And the stars diminish their brightness.

Joel 2:30 And I will show wonders in the heavens and in the earth: Blood and fire and pillars of smoke.

- Joel 3:16 The LORD also will roar from Zion, And utter His voice from Jerusalem; The <u>heavens</u> and earth will shake; But the LORD will be a shelter for His people, And the strength of the children of Israel.
- Habakkuk 3:3 God came from Teman, The Holy One from Mount Paran. Selah His glory covered the <u>heavens</u>, And the earth was full of His praise.
- Zephaniah 1:3 "I will consume man and beast; I will consume the birds of the <u>heavens</u>, The fish of the sea, And the stumbling blocks along with the wicked. I will cut off man from the face of the land," Says the LORD.
- Haggai 1:10 Therefore the heavens above you withhold the dew, and the earth withholds its fruit.
- Zechariah 8:12 'For the seed *shall be* prosperous, The vine shall give its fruit, The ground shall give her increase, And the <u>heavens</u> shall give their dew—I will cause the remnant of this people To possess all these.
- Zechariah 12:1 The burden of the word of the LORD against Israel. Thus says the LORD, who stretches out the <u>heavens</u>, lays the foundation of the earth, and forms the spirit of man within him.
- Matthew 3:16 When He had been baptized, Jesus came up immediately from the water; and behold, the <u>heavens</u> were opened to Him, and He saw the Spirit of God descending like a dove and alighting upon Him.
- Matthew 24:29 Immediately after the tribulation of those days the sun will be darkened, and the moon will not give its light; the stars will fall from heaven, and the powers of the <u>heavens</u> will be shaken.
- Mark 1:10 And immediately, coming up from the water, He saw the <u>heavens</u> parting and the Spirit descending upon Him like a dove.
- Mark 13:25 The stars of heaven will fall, and the powers in the heavens will be shaken.
- Luke 12:33 Sell what you have and give alms; provide yourselves money bags which do not grow old, a treasure in the <u>heavens</u> that does not fail, where no thief approaches nor moth destroys.
- Acts 2:34 For David did not ascend into the <u>heavens</u>, but he says himself: The LORD said to my Lord, "Sit at My right hand."
- Acts 7:56 And said, "Look! I see the <u>heavens</u> opened and the Son of Man standing at the right hand of God!"
- 2 Corinthians 5:1 For we know that if our earthly house, *this* tent, is destroyed, we have a building from God, a house not made with hands, eternal in the <u>heavens</u>.
- Ephesians 4:10 He who descended is also the One who ascended far above all the <u>heavens</u>, that He might fill all things.)
- Hebrews 1:10 And: "You, LORD, in the beginning laid the foundation of the earth, And the <u>heavens</u> are the work of Your hands."
- Hebrews 4:14 Seeing then that we have a great High Priest who has passed through the <u>heavens</u>, Jesus the Son of God, let us hold fast *our* confession.

- Hebrews 7:26 For such a High Priest was fitting for us, *who is* holy, harmless, undefiled, separate from sinners, and has become higher than the <u>heavens</u>.
- Hebrews 8:1 Now *this is* the main point of the things we are saying: We have such a High Priest, who is seated at the right hand of the throne of the Majesty in the <u>heavens</u>.
- Hebrews 9:23 Therefore *it was* necessary that the copies of the things in the <u>heavens</u> should be purified with these, but the heavenly things themselves with better sacrifices than these.
- 2 Peter 3:5 For this they willfully forget: that by the word of God the <u>heavens</u> were of old, and the earth standing out of water and in the water.
- 2 Peter 3:7 But the <u>heavens</u> and the earth *which* are now preserved by the same word, are reserved for fire until the day of judgment and perdition of ungodly men.
- 2 Peter 3:10 But the day of the Lord will come as a thief in the night, in which the <u>heavens</u> will pass away with a great noise, and the elements will melt with fervent heat; both the earth and the works that are in it will be burned up.
- 2 Peter 3:12 Looking for and hastening the coming of the day of God, because of which the <u>heavens</u> will be dissolved, being on fire, and the elements will melt with fervent heat?
- 2 Peter 3:13 Nevertheless we, according to His promise, look for new <u>heavens</u> and a new earth in which righteousness dwells.
- Revelation 12:12 Therefore rejoice, O <u>heavens</u>, and you who dwell in them! Woe to the inhabitants of the earth and the sea! For the devil has come down to you, having great wrath, because he knows that he has a short time.

## Heaven of Heavens

- 1 Kings 8:27 But will God indeed dwell on the earth? Behold, heaven and the <u>heaven of heavens</u> cannot contain You. How much less this temple which I have built!
- 2 Chronicles 2:6 But who is able to build Him a temple, since heaven and the <u>heaven of heavens</u> cannot contain Him? Who *am* I then, that I should build Him a temple, except to burn sacrifice before Him?
- 2 Chronicles 6:18 But will God indeed dwell with men on the earth? Behold, heaven and the <u>heaven of</u> <u>heavens</u> cannot contain You. How much less this temple which I have built!
- Nehemiah 9:6 You alone *are* the LORD; You have made heaven, The <u>heaven of heavens</u>, with all their host, The earth and everything on it, The seas and all that is in them, And You preserve them all. The host of heaven worships You.
- Psalms 68:33 To Him who rides on the <u>heaven of heavens</u>, *which were* of old! Indeed, He sends out His voice, a mighty voice.

# Third Heaven

2 Corinthians 12:2 I know a man in Christ who fourteen years ago—whether in the body I do not know, or whether out of the body I do not know, God knows—such a one was caught up to the <u>third heaven</u>.
