## In One Accord

# Fulfill my joy by being like—minded, having the same love, being of one accord, of one mind. Philippians 2:2

Studies included in this article are: One Mind; One Accord; One Heart; Are One; Agreed

#### One Mind

- 1 Chronicles 12:38 All these men of war, who could keep ranks, came to Hebron with a loyal heart, to make David king over all Israel; and all the rest of Israel were of one mind to make David king.
- Romans 15:6 That you may with one mind and one mouth glorify the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ.
- 2 Corinthians 13:11 Finally, brethren, farewell. Become complete. Be of good comfort, be of <u>one mind</u>, live in peace; and the God of love and peace will be with you.
- Philippians 1:27 Only let your conduct be worthy of the gospel of Christ, so that whether I come and see you or am absent, I may hear of your affairs, that you stand fast in one spirit, with <u>one mind</u> striving together for the faith of the gospel.
- Philippians 2:2 Fulfill my joy by being like-minded, having the same love, being of one accord, of one mind.
- 1 Peter 3:8 Finally, all *of you be* of <u>one mind</u>, having compassion for one another; love as brothers, *be* tenderhearted, *be* courteous.
- Revelation 17:13 These are of one mind, and they will give their power and authority to the beast.
- Revelation 17:17 For God has put it into their hearts to fulfill His purpose, to be of <u>one mind</u>, and to give their kingdom to the beast, until the words of God are fulfilled.

### One Accord

Joshua 9:2 That they gathered together to fight with Joshua and Israel with one accord.

- 1 Kings 22:13 Then the messenger who had gone to call Micaiah spoke to him, saying, "Now listen, the words of the prophets with <u>one accord</u> encourage the king. Please, let your word be like the word of one of them, and speak encouragement."
- 2 Chronicles 18:12 Then the messenger who had gone to call Micaiah spoke to him, saying, "Now listen, the words of the prophets with one accord encourage the king. Therefore please let your word be like *the word of* one of them, and speak encouragement."
- Zephaniah 3:9 For then I will restore to the peoples a pure language, That they all may call on the name of the LORD, To serve Him with one accord.

- Luke 14:18 But they all with <u>one accord</u> began to make excuses. The first said to him, I have bought a piece of ground, and I must go and see it. I ask you to have me excused.'
- Acts 1:14 These all continued with <u>one accord</u> in prayer and supplication, with the women and Mary the mother of Jesus, and with His brothers.
- Acts 2:1 When the Day of Pentecost had fully come, they were all with one accord in one place.
- Acts 2:46 So continuing daily with <u>one accord</u> in the temple, and breaking bread from house to house, they ate their food with gladness and simplicity of heart.
- Acts 4:24 So when they heard that, they raised their voice to God with <u>one accord</u> and said: "Lord, You *are* God, who made heaven and earth and the sea, and all that is in them.
- Acts 5:12 And through the hands of the apostles many signs and wonders were done among the people. And they were all with <u>one accord</u> in Solomon's Porch.
- Acts 7:57 Then they cried out with a loud voice, stopped their ears, and ran at him with one accord.
- Acts 8:6 And the multitudes with <u>one accord</u> heeded the things spoken by Philip, hearing and seeing the miracles which he did.
- Acts 12:20 Now Herod had been very angry with the people of Tyre and Sidon; but they came to him with one accord, and having made Blastus the king's personal aide their friend, they asked for peace, because their country was supplied with food by the king's *country*.
- Acts 15:25 It seemed good to us, being assembled with <u>one accord</u>, to send chosen men to you with our beloved Barnabas and Paul.
- Acts 18:12 When Gallio was proconsul of Achaia, the Jews with <u>one accord</u> rose up against Paul and brought him to the judgment seat.
- Acts 19:29 So the whole city was filled with confusion, and rushed into the theater with <u>one accord</u>, having seized Gaius and Aristarchus, Macedonians, Paul's travel companions.
- Philippians 2:2 Fulfill my joy by being like-minded, having the same love, being of one accord, of one mind.

### One Heart

- Jeremiah 32:39 Then I will give them <u>one heart</u> and one way, that they may fear Me forever, for the good of them and their children after them.
- Ezekiel 11:19 Then I will give them <u>one heart</u>, and I will put a new spirit within them, and take the stony heart out of their flesh, and give them a heart of flesh.
- Acts 4:32 Now the multitude of those who believed were of <u>one heart</u> and one soul; neither did anyone say that any of the things he possessed was his own, but they had all things in common.
- 2 Chronicles 30:12 Also the hand of God was on Judah to give them <u>singleness</u> of <u>heart</u> to obey the command of the king and the leaders, at the word of the LORD.

#### Are One

- Genesis 11:6 And the LORD said, "Indeed the people <u>are one</u> and they all have one language, and this is what they begin to do; now nothing that they propose to do will be withheld from them."
- Matthew 26:73 And a little later those who stood by came up and said to Peter, "Surely you also <u>are one</u> of them, for your speech betrays you."
- Mark 14:70 But he denied it again. And a little later those who stood by said to Peter again, "Surely you are one of them; for you are a Galilean, and your speech shows it."
- Romans 12:5 So we, being many, are one body in Christ, and individually members of one another.
- 1 Corinthians 3:8 Now he who plants and he who waters <u>are one</u>, and each one will receive his own reward according to his own labor.
- 1 Corinthians 10:17 For we, though many, are one bread and one body; for we all partake of that one bread.
- 1 Corinthians 12:12 For as the body is one and has many members, but all the members of that one body, being many, are one body, so also *is* Christ.

#### Agreed

- 2 Kings 12:8 And the priests <u>agreed</u> that they would neither receive *more* money from the people, nor repair the damages of the temple.
- 2 Chronicles 30:2 For the king and his leaders and all the assembly in Jerusalem had <u>agreed</u> to keep the Passover in the second month.
- 2 Chronicles 30:23 Then the whole assembly <u>agreed</u> to keep *the feast* another seven days, and they kept it *another* seven days with gladness.
- Daniel 2:9 If you do not make known the dream to me, *there is only* one decree for you! For you have <u>agreed</u> to speak lying and corrupt words before me till the time has changed. Therefore tell me the dream, and I shall know that you can give me its interpretation.
- Amos 3:3 Can two walk together, unless they are agreed?
- Matthew 20:2 Now when he had <u>agreed</u> with the laborers for a denarius a day, he sent them into his vineyard.
- Luke 22:5 And they were glad, and <u>agreed</u> to give him money.
- John 9:22 His parents said these *things* because they feared the Jews, for the Jews had <u>agreed</u> already that if anyone confessed *that* He *was* Christ, he would be put out of the synagogue.
- Acts 5:9 Then Peter said to her, "How is it that you have <u>agreed</u> together to test the Spirit of the Lord? Look, the feet of those who have buried your husband *are* at the door, and they will carry you out."

Acts 5:40 And they <u>agreed</u> with him, and when they had called for the apostles and beaten *them*, they commanded that they should not speak in the name of Jesus, and let them go.

Acts 23:20 And he said, "The Jews have <u>agreed</u> to ask that you bring Paul down to the council tomorrow, as though they were going to inquire more fully about him."
