Call on the Name of the Lord

- Genesis 4:26 And as for Seth, to him also a son was born; and he named him Enosh. Then *men* began to call on the <u>name of the LORD</u>.
- Genesis 12:8 And he moved from there to the mountain east of Bethel, and he pitched his tent *with* Bethel on the west and Ai on the east; there he built an altar to the LORD and called on the <u>name of the LORD</u>.
- Genesis 13:4 to the place of the altar which he had made there at first. And there Abram called on the <u>name</u> of the <u>LORD</u>.
- Genesis 16:13 Then she called the <u>name of the LORD</u> who spoke to her, You–Are–the–God–Who–Sees; for she said, "Have I also here seen Him who sees me?"
- Genesis 21:33 Then *Abraham* planted a tamarisk tree in Beersheba, and there called on the <u>name of the LORD</u>, the Everlasting God.
- Genesis 26:25 So he built an altar there and called on the <u>name of the LORD</u>, and he pitched his tent there; and there Isaac's servants dug a well.
- 1 Kings 18:24 Then you call on the name of your gods, and I will call on the <u>name of the LORD</u>; and the God who answers by fire, He is God." So all the people answered and said, "It is well spoken."
- 2 Kings 5:11 But Naaman became furious, and went away and said, "Indeed, I said to myself, 'He will surely come out *to me*, and stand and call on the <u>name of the LORD</u> his God, and wave his hand over the place, and heal the leprosy.'
- Psalms 116:4 Then I called upon the <u>name of the LORD</u>: "O LORD, I implore You, deliver my soul!"
- Psalms 116:13 I will take up the cup of salvation, And call upon the <u>name of the LORD</u>.
- Psalms 116:17 I will offer to You the sacrifice of thanksgiving, And will call upon the <u>name of the LORD</u>.

Called by the Name of the Lord

Deuteronomy 28:10 Then all peoples of the earth shall see that you are called by the <u>name of the LORD</u>, and they shall be afraid of you.

Take the Name of the Lord

- Exodus 20:7 You shall not take the <u>name of the LORD</u> your God in vain, for the LORD will not hold *him* guiltless who takes His name in vain.
- Leviticus 24:11 And the Israelite woman's son blasphemed the <u>name of the LORD</u> and cursed; and so they brought him to Moses. (His mother's name *was* Shelomith the daughter of Dibri, of the tribe of Dan.)
- Leviticus 24:16 And whoever blasphemes the <u>name of the LORD</u> shall surely be put to death. All the congregation shall certainly stone him, the stranger as well as him who is born in the land. When he blasphemes the <u>name of the LORD</u>, he shall be put to death.
- Deuteronomy 5:11 You shall not take the <u>name of the LORD</u> your God in vain, for the LORD will not hold *him* guiltless who takes His name in vain.
- 1 Samuel 20:42 Then Jonathan said to David, "Go in peace, since we have both sworn in the <u>name of the LORD</u>, saying, 'May the LORD be between you and me, and between your descendants and my descendants, forever." So he arose and departed, and Jonathan went into the city."
- Isaiah 48:1 Hear this, O house of Jacob, Who are called by the name of Israel, And have come forth from the wellsprings of Judah; Who swear by the <u>name of the LORD</u>, And make mention of the God of Israel, *But* not in truth or in righteousness.

Proclaim the Name of the Lord

- Exodus 33:19 Then He said, "I will make all My goodness pass before you, and I will proclaim the <u>name of the LORD</u> before you. I will be gracious to whom I will be gracious, and I will have compassion on whom I will have compassion."
- Exodus 34:5 Now the LORD descended in the cloud and stood with him there, and proclaimed the <u>name of the LORD</u>.
- Deuteronomy 32:3 For I proclaim the <u>name of the LORD</u>: Ascribe greatness to our God.
- Psalms 102:21 To declare the <u>name of the LORD</u> in Zion, And His praise in Jerusalem.

Minister in the Name of the Lord

- Deuteronomy 18:5 "For the LORD your God has chosen him out of all your tribes to stand to minister in the <u>name of the LORD</u>, him and his sons forever.
- Deuteronomy 18:7 Then he may serve in the <u>name of the LORD</u> his God as all his brethren the Levites *do*, who stand there before the LORD.

Prophesy/Speak in the Name of the Lord

- Deuteronomy 18:22 When a prophet speaks in the <u>name of the LORD</u>, if the thing does not happen or come to pass, that *is* the thing which the LORD has not spoken; the prophet has spoken it presumptuously; you shall not be afraid of him.
- 1 Chronicles 21:19 So David went up at the word of Gad, which he had spoken in the <u>name of the LORD</u>.
- Jeremiah 11:21 Therefore thus says the LORD concerning the men of Anathoth who seek your life, saying, 'Do not prophesy in the <u>name of the LORD</u>, lest you die by our hand'—
- Jeremiah 26:16 So the princes and all the people said to the priests and the prophets, "This man does not deserve to die. For he has spoken to us in the <u>name of the LORD</u> our God."
- Jeremiah 26:9 Why have you prophesied in the <u>name of the LORD</u>, saying, 'This house shall be like Shiloh, and this city shall be desolate, without an inhabitant'?" And all the people were gathered against Jeremiah in the house of the LORD.
- Jeremiah 26:20 Now there was also a man who prophesied in the <u>name of the LORD</u>, Urijah the son of Shemaiah of Kirjath Jearim, who prophesied against this city and against this land according to all the words of Jeremiah.
- Jeremiah 44:16 As for the word that you have spoken to us in the <u>name of the LORD</u>, we will not listen to you!

Bless in the Name of the Lord

- Deuteronomy 21:5 Then the priests, the sons of Levi, shall come near, for the LORD your God has chosen them to minister to Him and to bless in the <u>name of the LORD</u>; by their word every controversy and every assault shall be *settled*.
- 2 Samuel 6:18 And when David had finished offering burnt offerings and peace offerings, he blessed the people in the <u>name of the LORD</u> of hosts.
- 1 Chronicles 16:2 And when David had finished offering the burnt offerings and the peace offerings, he blessed the people in the <u>name of the LORD</u>.

Bless/Praise the Name of the Lord

- Job 1:21 And he said: "Naked I came from my mother's womb, And naked shall I return there. The LORD gave, and the LORD has taken away; Blessed be the <u>name of the LORD</u>."
- Psalms 7:17 I will praise the LORD according to His righteousness, And will sing praise to the <u>name of the LORD</u> Most High.
- Psalms 20:7 Some *trust* in chariots, and some in horses; But we will remember the <u>name of the LORD</u> our God.
- Psalms 102:15 So the nations shall fear the <u>name of the LORD</u>, And all the kings of the earth Your glory.
- Psalms 113:1 Praise the LORD! Praise, O servants of the LORD, Praise the name of the LORD!
- Isaiah 59:19 So shall they fear The <u>name of the LORD</u> from the west, And His glory from the rising of the sun; When the enemy comes in like a flood, The Spirit of the LORD will lift up a standard against him.
- Joel 2:26 You shall eat in plenty and be satisfied, And praise the <u>name of the LORD</u> your God, Who has dealt wondrously with you; And My people shall never be put to shame.
- Psalms 113:2 Blessed be the name of the LORD From this time forth and forevermore!
- Psalms 122:4 Where the tribes go up, The tribes of the LORD, To the Testimony of Israel, To give thanks to the <u>name of the LORD</u>.
- Psalms 135:1 Praise the LORD! Praise the name of the LORD; Praise Him, O you servants of the LORD!
- Psalms 148:5 Let them praise the <u>name of the LORD</u>, For He commanded and they were created.
- Psalms 148:13 Let them praise the <u>name of the LORD</u>, For His name alone is exalted; His glory is above the earth and heaven.
- Isaiah 24:15 Therefore glorify the LORD in the dawning light, The <u>name of the LORD</u> God of Israel in the coastlands of the sea.

Because of the Name of the Lord

Joshua 9:9 So they said to him: "From a very far country your servants have come, because of the <u>name of</u> the <u>LORD</u> your God; for we have heard of His fame, and all that He did in Egypt."

In the Name of the Lord

1 Samuel 17:45 Then David said to the Philistine, "You come to me with a sword, with a spear, and with a javelin. But I come to you in the <u>name of the LORD</u> of hosts, the God of the armies of Israel, whom you have defied.

- 1 Kings 18:32 Then with the stones he built an altar in the <u>name of the LORD</u>; and he made a trench around the altar large enough to hold two seahs of seed.
- 1 Kings 22:16 So the king said to him, "How many times shall I make you swear that you tell me nothing but the truth in the <u>name of the LORD</u>?"
- 2 Kings 2:24 So he turned around and looked at them, and pronounced a curse on them in the <u>name of the LORD</u>. And two female bears came out of the woods and mauled forty—two of the youths.
- 2 Chronicles 18:15 So the king said to him, "How many times shall I make you swear that you tell me nothing but the truth in the <u>name of the LORD</u>?"
- 2 Chronicles 33:18 Now the rest of the acts of Manasseh, his prayer to his God, and the words of the seers who spoke to him in the <u>name of the LORD</u> God of Israel, indeed they *are written* in the book of the kings of Israel.
- Psalms 118:10 All nations surrounded me, But in the <u>name of the LORD</u> I will destroy them.
- Psalms 118:11 They surrounded me, Yes, they surrounded me; But in the <u>name of the LORD</u> I will destroy them.
- Psalms 118:12 They surrounded me like bees; They were quenched like a fire of thorns; For in the <u>name of the LORD</u> I will destroy them.
- Psalms 118:26 Blessed *is* he who comes in the <u>name of the LORD!</u> We have blessed you from the house of the LORD.
- Psalms 124:8 Our help is in the <u>name of the LORD</u>, Who made heaven and earth.
- Psalms 129:8 Neither let those who pass by them say, "The blessing of the LORD be upon you; We bless you in the name of the LORD!"

For the Name of the Lord

- 1 Kings 3:2 Meanwhile the people sacrificed at the high places, because there was no house built for the name of the LORD until those days.
- 1 Kings 5:3 You know how my father David could not build a house for the <u>name of the LORD</u> his God because of the wars which were fought against him on every side, until the LORD put *his foes* under the soles of his feet.
- 1 Kings 5:5 And behold, I propose to build a house for the <u>name of the LORD</u> my God, as the LORD spoke to my father David, saying, "Your son, whom I will set on your throne in your place, he shall build the house for My name."
- 1 Kings 8:17 Now it was in the heart of my father David to build a temple for the <u>name of the LORD</u> God of Israel.

- 1 Kings 8:20 So the LORD has fulfilled His word which He spoke; and I have filled the position of my father David, and sit on the throne of Israel, as the LORD promised; and I have built a temple for the name of the LORD God of Israel.
- 1 Kings 10:1 Now when the queen of Sheba heard of the fame of Solomon concerning the <u>name of the LORD</u>, she came to test him with hard questions.
- 1 Chronicles 22:19 Now set your heart and your soul to seek the LORD your God. Therefore arise and build the sanctuary of the LORD God, to bring the ark of the covenant of the LORD and the holy articles of God into the house that is to be built for the name of the LORD."
- 2 Chronicles 2:1 Then Solomon determined to build a temple for the <u>name of the LORD</u>, and a royal house for himself.
- 2 Chronicles 2:4 Behold, I am building a temple for the <u>name of the LORD</u> my God, to dedicate *it* to Him, to burn before Him sweet incense, for the continual showbread, for the burnt offerings morning and evening, on the Sabbaths, on the New Moons, and on the set feasts of the LORD our God. This *is an ordinance* forever to Israel.
- 2 Chronicles 6:7 Now it was in the heart of my father David to build a temple for the <u>name of the LORD</u> God of Israel.
- 2 Chronicles 6:10 So the LORD has fulfilled His word which He spoke, and I have filled the position of my father David, and sit on the throne of Israel, as the LORD promised; and I have built the temple for the name of the LORD God of Israel.

To the Name of the Lord

- 1 Chronicles 22:7 And David said to Solomon: "My son, as for me, it was in my mind to build a house to the name_of_the_LORD my God."
- Isaiah 60:9 Surely the coastlands shall wait for Me; And the ships of Tarshish *will come* first, To bring your sons from afar, Their silver and their gold with them, To the <u>name of the LORD</u> your God, And to the Holy One of Israel, Because He has glorified you.
- Jeremiah 3:17 At that time Jerusalem shall be called The Throne of the LORD, and all the nations shall be gathered to it, to the <u>name of the LORD</u>, to Jerusalem. No more shall they follow the dictates of their evil hearts.

Place of the Name of the Lord

Proverbs 18:10 The name of the LORD is a strong tower; The righteous run to it and are safe.

Isaiah 18:7 In that time a present will be brought to the LORD of hosts From a people tall and smooth of skin, And from a people terrible from their beginning onward, A nation powerful and treading down, Whose land the rivers divide—To the place of the name of the LORD of hosts, To Mount Zion.
