# Sing (99x's)

- Exodus 15:1 Then Moses and the children of Israel sang this song to the LORD, and spoke, saying: "I will sing to the LORD, For He has triumphed gloriously! The horse and its rider He has thrown into the sea!"
- Exodus 15:21 And Miriam answered them: "Sing to the LORD, For He has triumphed gloriously! The horse and its rider He has thrown into the sea!"
- Numbers 21:17 Then Israel sang this song: "Spring up, O well! All of you sing to it-"
- Judges 5:3 Hear, O kings! Give ear, O princes! I, even I, will sing to the LORD; I will sing praise to the LORD God of Israel.
- Judges 5:12 "Awake, awake, Deborah! Awake, awake, sing a song! Arise, Barak, and lead your captives away, O son of Abinoam!
- 1 Samuel 21:11 And the servants of Achish said to him, "*Is* this not David the king of the land? Did they not sing of him to one another in dances, saying: 'Saul has slain his thousands, And David his ten thousands'?"
- 2 Samuel 22:50 Therefore I will give thanks to You, O LORD, among the Gentiles, And sing praises to Your name.
- 1 Chronicles 16:9 Sing to Him, sing psalms to Him; Talk of all His wondrous works!

# Singing (25x's)

- Exodus 32:18 But he said: "It is not the noise of the shout of victory, Nor the noise of the cry of defeat, But the sound of singing I hear."
- 1 Samuel 18:6 Now it had happened as they were coming *home*, when David was returning from the slaughter of the Philistine, that the women had come out of all the cities of Israel, <u>singing</u> and dancing, to meet King Saul, with tambourines, with joy, and with musical instruments.
- 2 Samuel 19:35 "I *am* today eighty years old. Can I discern between the good and bad? Can your servant taste what I eat or what I drink? Can I hear any longer the voice of <u>singing</u> men and <u>singing</u> women? Why then should your servant be a further burden to my lord the king?
- 1 Chronicles 13:8 Then David and all Israel played *music* before God with all *their* might, with <u>singing</u>, on harps, on stringed instruments, on tambourines, on cymbals, and with trumpets.
- 2 Chronicles 23:18 Also Jehoiada appointed the oversight of the house of the LORD to the hand of the priests, the Levites, whom David had assigned in the house of the LORD, to offer the burnt offerings of

the LORD, as *it is* written in the Law of Moses, with rejoicing and with singing, as it was established by David.

- 2 Chronicles 30:21 So the children of Israel who were present at Jerusalem kept the Feast of Unleavened Bread seven days with great gladness; and the Levites and the priests praised the LORD day by day, *singing* to the LORD, accompanied by loud instruments.
- 2 Chronicles 35:25 Jeremiah also lamented for Josiah. And to this day all the <u>singing</u> men and the <u>singing</u> women speak of Josiah in their lamentations. They made it a custom in Israel; and indeed they *are* written in the Laments.
- Nehemiah 12:27 Now at the dedication of the wall of Jerusalem they sought out the Levites in all their places, to bring them to Jerusalem to celebrate the dedication with gladness, both with thanksgivings and <u>singing</u>, *with* cymbals and stringed instruments and harps.
- Psalms 100:2 Serve the LORD with gladness; Come before His presence with singing.
- Psalms 126:2 Then our mouth was filled with laughter, And our tongue with <u>singing</u>. Then they said among the nations, "The LORD has done great things for them."
- Song of Solomon 2:12 The flowers appear on the earth; The time of <u>singing</u> has come, And the voice of the turtledove Is heard in our land.
- Isaiah 14:7 The whole earth is at rest and quiet; They break forth into singing.
- Isaiah 16:10 Gladness is taken away, And joy from the plentiful field; In the vineyards there will be no singing, Nor will there be shouting; No treaders will tread out wine in the presses; I have made their shouting cease.
- Isaiah 35:2 It shall blossom abundantly and rejoice, Even with joy and <u>singing</u>. The glory of Lebanon shall be given to it, The excellence of Carmel and Sharon. They shall see the glory of the LORD, The excellency of our God.
- Isaiah 35:10 And the ransomed of the LORD shall return, And come to Zion with <u>singing</u>, With everlasting joy on their heads. They shall obtain joy and gladness, And sorrow and sighing shall flee away.
- Isaiah 44:23 Sing, O heavens, for the LORD has done *it*! Shout, you lower parts of the earth; Break forth into singing, you mountains, O forest, and every tree in it! For the LORD has redeemed Jacob, And glorified Himself in Israel.
- Isaiah 48:20 Go forth from Babylon! Flee from the Chaldeans! With a voice of <u>singing</u>, Declare, proclaim this, Utter it to the end of the earth; Say, "The LORD has redeemed His servant Jacob!"
- Isaiah 49:13 Sing, O heavens! Be joyful, O earth! And break out in <u>singing</u>, O mountains! For the LORD has comforted His people, And will have mercy on His afflicted.
- Isaiah 51:11 So the ransomed of the LORD shall return, And come to Zion with singing, With everlasting joy on their heads. They shall obtain joy and gladness; Sorrow and sighing shall flee away.

- Isaiah 54:1 "Sing, O barren, You *who* have not borne! Break forth into <u>singing</u>, and cry aloud, You *who* have not labored with child! For more *are* the children of the desolate Than the children of the married woman," says the LORD.
- Isaiah 55:12 "For you shall go out with joy, And be led out with peace; The mountains and the hills Shall break forth into singing before you, And all the trees of the field shall clap *their* hands.
- Zephaniah 3:17 The LORD your God in your midst, The Mighty One, will save; He will rejoice over you with gladness, He will quiet *you* with His love, He will rejoice over you with <u>singing</u>."
- Acts 16:25 But at midnight Paul and Silas were praying and <u>singing</u> hymns to God, and the prisoners were listening to them.
- Ephesians 5:19 speaking to one another in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing and making melody in your heart to the Lord,
- Colossians 3:16 Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly in all wisdom, teaching and admonishing one another in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing with grace in your hearts to the Lord.

#### Singer (1x)

1 Chronicles 6:33 And these *are* the ones who ministered with their sons: Of the sons of the Kohathites *were* Heman the <u>singer</u>, the son of Joel, the son of Samuel,

# Singers (37x's)

- 1 Kings 10:12 And the king made steps of the almug wood for the house of the LORD and for the king's house, also harps and stringed instruments for <u>singers</u>. There never again came such almug wood, nor has the like been seen to this day.
- 1 Chronicles 9:33 These are the <u>singers</u>, heads of the fathers' *houses* of the Levites, *who lodged* in the chambers, *and were* free *from other duties*; for they were employed in *that* work day and night.
- 1 Chronicles 15:16 Then David spoke to the leaders of the Levites to appoint their brethren *to be* the <u>singers</u> accompanied by instruments of music, stringed instruments, harps, and cymbals, by raising the voice with resounding joy.
- 1 Chronicles 15:19 the singers, Heman, Asaph, and Ethan, were to sound the cymbals of bronze;
- 1 Chronicles 15:27 David was clothed with a robe of fine linen, as were all the Levites who bore the ark, the <u>singers</u>, and Chenaniah the music master *with* the <u>singers</u>. David also wore a linen ephod.
- 2 Chronicles 5:12 and the Levites *who were* the <u>singers</u>, all those of Asaph and Heman and Jeduthun, with their sons and their brethren, stood at the east end of the altar, clothed in white linen, having cymbals, stringed instruments and harps, and with them one hundred and twenty priests sounding with trumpets.

- 2 Chronicles 5:13 indeed it came to pass, when the trumpeters and <u>singers</u> *were* as one, to make one sound to be heard in praising and thanking the LORD, and when they lifted up their voice with the trumpets and cymbals and instruments of music, and praised the LORD, *saying: "For He is* good, For His mercy *endures* forever," that the house, the house of the LORD, was filled with a cloud,
- 2 Chronicles 9:11 And the king made walkways *of* the algum wood for the house of the LORD and for the king's house, also harps and stringed instruments for <u>singers</u>; and there were none such *as these* seen before in the land of Judah.
- 2 Chronicles 23:13 When she looked, there was the king standing by his pillar at the entrance; and the leaders and the trumpeters *were* by the king. All the people of the land were rejoicing and blowing trumpets, also the <u>singers</u> with musical instruments, and those who led in praise. So Athaliah tore her clothes and said, "Treason! Treason!"
- 2 Chronicles 29:28 So all the assembly worshiped, the <u>singers</u> sang, and the trumpeters sounded; all *this continued* until the burnt offering was finished.
- 2 Chronicles 35:15 And the <u>singers</u>, the sons of Asaph, *were* in their places, according to the command of David, Asaph, Heman, and Jeduthun the king's seer. Also the gatekeepers were at each gate; they did not have to leave their position, because their brethren the Levites prepared portions for them.
- Ezra 2:41 The singers: the sons of Asaph, one hundred and twenty-eight.
- Ezra 2:65 besides their male and female servants, of whom *there were* seven thousand three hundred and thirty–seven; and they had two hundred men and women <u>singers</u>.
- Ezra 2:70 So the priests and the Levites, *some* of the people, the <u>singers</u>, the gatekeepers, and the Nethinim, dwelt in their cities, and all Israel in their cities.
- Ezra 7:7 *Some* of the children of Israel, the priests, the Levites, the <u>singers</u>, the gatekeepers, and the Nethinim came up to Jerusalem in the seventh year of King Artaxerxes.
- Ezra 7:24 Also we inform you that it shall not be lawful to impose tax, tribute, or custom on any of the priests, Levites, <u>singers</u>, gatekeepers, Nethinim, or servants of this house of God.
- Ezra 10:24 Also of the singers: Eliashib; and of the gatekeepers: Shallum, Telem, and Uri.
- Nehemiah 7:1 Then it was, when the wall was built and I had hung the doors, when the gatekeepers, the <u>singers</u>, and the Levites had been appointed,
- Nehemiah 7:44 The singers: the sons of Asaph, one hundred and forty-eight.
- Nehemiah 7:67 besides their male and female servants, of whom *there were* seven thousand three hundred and thirty–seven; and they had two hundred and forty–five men and women <u>singers</u>.
- Nehemiah 7:73 So the priests, the Levites, the gatekeepers, the <u>singers</u>, *some* of the people, the Nethinim, and all Israel dwelt in their cities. When the seventh month came, the children of Israel *were* in their cities.
- Nehemiah 10:28 Now the rest of the people—the priests, the Levites, the gatekeepers, the <u>singers</u>, the Nethinim, and all those who had separated themselves from the peoples of the lands to the Law of God, their wives, their sons, and their daughters, everyone who had knowledge and understanding—

- Nehemiah 10:39 For the children of Israel and the children of Levi shall bring the offering of the grain, of the new wine and the oil, to the storerooms where the articles of the sanctuary *are, where* the priests who minister and the gatekeepers and the <u>singers</u> *are*; and we will not neglect the house of our God.
- Nehemiah 11:22 Also the overseer of the Levites at Jerusalem *was* Uzzi the son of Bani, the son of Hashabiah, the son of Mattaniah, the son of Micha, of the sons of Asaph, the <u>singers</u> in charge of the service of the house of God.
- Nehemiah 11:23 For *it was* the king's command concerning them that a certain portion should be for the singers, a quota day by day.
- Nehemiah 12:28 And the sons of the singers gathered together from the countryside around Jerusalem, from the villages of the Netophathites,
- Nehemiah 12:29 from the house of Gilgal, and from the fields of Geba and Azmaveth; for the <u>singers</u> had built themselves villages all around Jerusalem.
- Nehemiah 12:42 also Maaseiah, Shemaiah, Eleazar, Uzzi, Jehohanan, Malchijah, Elam, and Ezer. The singers sang loudly with Jezrahiah the director.
- Nehemiah 12:45 Both the <u>singers</u> and the gatekeepers kept the charge of their God and the charge of the purification, according to the command of David *and* Solomon his son.
- Nehemiah 12:46 For in the days of David and Asaph of old *there were* chiefs of the <u>singers</u>, and songs of praise and thanksgiving to God.
- Nehemiah 12:47 In the days of Zerubbabel and in the days of Nehemiah all Israel gave the portions for the <u>singers</u> and the gatekeepers, a portion for each day. They also consecrated *holy things* for the Levites, and the Levites consecrated *them* for the children of Aaron.
- Nehemiah 13:5 And he had prepared for him a large room, where previously they had stored the grain offerings, the frankincense, the articles, the tithes of grain, the new wine and oil, which were commanded *to be given* to the Levites and <u>singers</u> and gatekeepers, and the offerings for the priests.
- Nehemiah 13:10 I also realized that the portions for the Levites had not been given *them*; for each of the Levites and the <u>singers</u> who did the work had gone back to his field.
- Psalms 68:25 The <u>singers</u> went before, the players on instruments *followed* after; Among *them were* the maidens playing timbrels.
- Psalms 87:7 Both the singers and the players on instruments say, "All my springs are in you."
- Ecclesiastes 2:8 I also gathered for myself silver and gold and the special treasures of kings and of the provinces. I acquired male and female <u>singers</u>, the delights of the sons of men, *and* musical instruments of all kinds.
- Ezekiel 40:44 Outside the inner gate *were* the chambers for the <u>singers</u> in the inner court, one facing south at the side of the northern gateway, and the other facing north at the side of the southern gateway.

- Judges 5:1 Then Deborah and Barak the son of Abinoam sang on that day, saying...
- 1 Samuel 18:7 So the women sang as they danced, and said: "Saul has slain his thousands, And David his ten thousands."
- 1 Samuel 29:5 "*Is* this not David, of whom they <u>sang</u> to one another in dances, saying: 'Saul has slain his thousands, And David his ten thousands'?"
