- Psalms 45:17 I will make <u>Your name</u> to be remembered in all generations; Therefore the people shall praise You <u>forever</u> and ever.
- Psalms 52:9 I will praise You forever, Because You have done *it*; And in the presence of Your saints I will wait on Your name, for *it is* good.
- Psalms 61:8 So I will sing praise to Your name forever, That I may daily perform my vows.
- Psalms 74:10 O God, how long will the adversary reproach? Will the enemy blaspheme Your name forever?
- Psalms 102:12 But You, O LORD, shall endure <u>forever</u>, And the remembrance of <u>Your name</u> to all generations.
- Psalms 135:13 Your name, O LORD, endures forever, Your fame, O LORD, throughout all generations.
- Psalms 145:1 A Praise of David. I will extol You, my God, O King; And I will bless <u>Your name forever</u> and ever.

Psalms 145:2 Every day I will bless You, And I will praise Your name forever and ever.

Isaiah 63:16 Doubtless You are our Father, Though Abraham was ignorant of us, And Israel does not acknowledge us. You, O LORD, are our Father; Our Redeemer from Everlasting is Your name.

Your Name's Place

- 2 Chronicles 6:20 That Your eyes may be open toward this temple day and night, toward the place where *You* said *You would* put <u>Your name</u>, that You may hear the prayer which Your servant prays toward this place.
- 2 Chronicles 20:9 If disaster comes upon us—sword, judgment, pestilence, or famine—we will stand before this temple and in Your presence (for <u>Your name</u> *is* in this temple), and cry out to You in our affliction, and You will hear and save.'
- Psalms 74:7 They have set fire to Your sanctuary; They have defiled the dwelling place of <u>Your name</u> to the ground.

Your Name's Sake

- 1 Kings 8:41 Moreover, concerning a foreigner, who *is* not of Your people Israel, but has come from a far country for <u>Your name's sake</u>
- Psalms 25:11 For Your name's sake, O LORD, Pardon my iniquity, for it is great.
- Psalms 31:3 For You are my rock and my fortress; Therefore, for Your name's sake, Lead me and guide me.
- Psalms 79:9 Help us, O God of our salvation, For the glory of Your name; And deliver us, and provide atonement for our sins, For <u>Your name's sake!</u>
- Psalms 109:21 But You, O GOD the Lord, Deal with me for <u>Your name's sake</u>; Because Your mercy *is* good, deliver me.
- Psalms 143:11 Revive me, O LORD, for <u>Your name's sake</u>! For Your righteousness' sake bring my soul out of trouble.
- Jeremiah 14:7 O LORD, though our iniquities testify against us, Do it for <u>Your name's sake</u>; For our backslidings are many, We have sinned against You.
- Jeremiah 14:21 Do not abhor *us*, for <u>Your name's sake</u>; Do not disgrace the throne of Your glory. Remember, do not break Your covenant with us.

What Is Your Name?

- Genesis 32:29 Then Jacob asked, saying, "Tell *me* Your name, I pray." And He said, "Why *is* it *that* you ask about My name?" And He blessed him there.
- Judges 13:17 Then Manoah said to the Angel of the LORD, "What *is* <u>Your name</u>, that when Your words come *to pass* we may honor You?"
