## ***Everything's Better With Jesus - Hebrews 7:14 – 8:6***

### **BETTER!**

**Ecclesiastes 9:4** But for him who is joined to all the living there is hope, for a living dog is better than a dead lion.

**Psalms 63:3** Because Your lovingkindness is **better than life**, My lips shall praise You.

**Psalms 84:10** For a day in Your courts is **better than a thousand**. I would rather be a doorkeeper in the house of my God Than dwell in the tents of wickedness.

**Psalms 119:72** the law of Your mouth is **better to me Than thousands of coins of gold and silver**.

**Philippians 1:23** For I am hard-pressed between the two, having a desire to depart and **be with Christ, which is far better**.

**Hebrews 1:4** having become so much **better than the angels**, as He has by inheritance obtained a more excellent name than they.

**Hebrews 6:9** But, beloved, we are confident of **better things concerning you**, yes, things that accompany salvation, though we speak in this manner.

**Hebrews 7:7** Now beyond all contradiction the lesser is blessed by the better.

**Hebrews 7:19** for the law made nothing perfect; on the other hand, there is the bringing in of a **better hope**, through which we draw near to God.

**Hebrews 7:22** by so much more Jesus has become a surety of a **better covenant**.

**Hebrews 8:6** But now He has obtained a more excellent ministry, inasmuch as He is also Mediator of a **better covenant**, which was established on better promises.

**Hebrews 9:23** Therefore it was necessary that the copies of the things in the heavens should be purified with these, but the heavenly things themselves with **better sacrifices** than these.

**Hebrews 10:34** for you had compassion on me in my chains, and joyfully accepted the plundering of your goods, knowing that you have a **better and an enduring possession** for yourselves in heaven.

**Hebrews 11:16** But now they desire a **better, that is, a heavenly country**. Therefore God is not ashamed to be called their God, for He has prepared a city for them.

**Hebrews 11:35** Women received their dead raised to life again. Others were tortured, not accepting deliverance, that they might obtain a **better resurrection**.

**Hebrews 11:40** God having **provided something better for us**, that they should not be made perfect apart from us.

**Hebrews 12:24** to Jesus the Mediator of the new covenant, and to the blood of sprinkling that speaks **better things** than that of Abel.

### **Hebrews 8:25**

- He is the ONLY One who is able to save
  - He is the ONLY One who knows the *uttermost* of each of us
  - He is the ONLY One who can truly intercede for us
  - And He NEVER stops - His priesthood continues forever and cannot change

### **Draw Near**

**Exodus 3:5** Then He said, "Do not **draw near** this place. Take your sandals off your feet, for the place where you stand is holy ground."

**1 Samuel 14:36** Now Saul said, "Let us go down after the Philistines by night, and plunder them until the morning light; and let us not leave a man of them." And they said, "Do whatever seems good to you." Then the priest said, "Let us **draw near** to God here."

**Psalms 73:28** But it is good for me to **draw near** to God; I have put my trust in the Lord God, that I may declare all Your works.

**Jeremiah 30:21** Their nobles shall be from among them, And their governor shall come from their midst; Then I will cause him to **draw near**, And he shall approach Me; For who is this who pledged his heart to approach Me?' says the Lord.

**Matthew 15:8** 'These people **draw near** to Me with their mouth, And honor Me with their lips, But their heart is far from Me.

**Hebrews 10:22** let us **draw near** with a true heart in full assurance of faith, having our hearts sprinkled from an evil conscience and our bodies washed with pure water.

**James 4:8** **Draw near** to God and He will draw near to you. Cleanse your hands, you sinners; and purify your hearts, you double-minded.

### **Once For All**

**Romans 6:10** For the death that He died, He died to sin **once for all**; but the life that He lives, He lives to God.

**Hebrews 7:27** who does not need daily, as those high priests, to offer up sacrifices, first for His own sins and then for the people's, for this He did **once for all** when He offered up Himself.

**Hebrews 9:12** Not with the blood of goats and calves, but with His own blood He entered the Most Holy Place **once for all**, having obtained eternal redemption.

**Hebrews 10:10** By that will we have been sanctified through the offering of the body of Jesus Christ **once for all**.

**Jude 1:3** Beloved, while I was very diligent to write to you concerning our common salvation, I found it necessary to write to you exhorting you to contend earnestly for the faith which was **once for all** delivered to the saints.
