**Psalm 28:2** Hear the voice of my supplications When I cry to You, When I lift up my hands toward Your holy sanctuary.

Psalm 63:4 Thus I will bless You while I live; I will lift up my hands in Your name.

Psalm 134:2 Lift up your hands in the sanctuary, And bless the Lord.

**Psalm 141:2** Let my prayer be set before You as incense, The lifting up of my hands as the evening sacrifice.

**Lamentations 2:19** "Arise, cry out in the night, at the beginning of the watches; Pour out your heart like water before the face of the Lord. <u>Lift your hands toward Him</u> for the life of your young children, who faint from hunger at the head of every street."

## **Root of Bitterness**

**Deuteronomy 29:18-19** so that there may not be among you man or woman or family or tribe, whose heart turns away today from the Lord our God, to go and serve the gods of these nations, and that there may not be among you a <u>root bearing bitterness</u> or wormwood; and so it may not happen, when he hears the words of this curse, that he blesses himself in his heart, saying, 'I shall have peace, even though I follow the dictates of my heart'—as though the drunkard could be included with the sober.
