### The Warning - Hebrews 6:4-6

### The Illustration - Hebrews 6:7-8

#### Hearts that say “Yes”

- Receives the provision from heaven
- The provision of rain is *often*
- Bears fruit
- Useful
- Receives blessings from God

#### Hearts that say “No”

- Bears thorns and briers
- Rejected
- Cursed
- End result is being burned up

**Genesis 1:26** Then God said, “**Let Us** make man in Our image, according to Our likeness;

**Genesis 11:3-4** Then they said to one another, “Come, **let us** make bricks and bake them thoroughly.” They had brick for stone, and they had asphalt for mortar. And they said, “Come, **let us** build ourselves a city, and a tower whose top is in the heavens; **let us** make a name for ourselves, lest we be scattered abroad over the face of the whole earth.”

**Genesis 11:7** Come, **let Us** go down and there confuse their language, that they may not understand one another’s speech.”

**Genesis 19:32** Come, **let us** make our father drink wine, and we will lie with him, that we may preserve the lineage of our father.”

**Numbers 13:30** Then Caleb quieted the people before Moses, and said, “**Let us** go up at once and take possession, for we are well able to overcome it.”

**Nehemiah 2:18** And I told them of the hand of my God which had been good upon me, and also of the king’s words that he had spoken to me. So they said, “**Let us** rise up and build.” Then they set their hands to this good work.

**Psalms 34:3** Oh, magnify the Lord with me, And **let us** exalt His name together.

**Psalms 95:1-2** Oh come, **let us** sing to the Lord! **Let us** shout joyfully to the Rock of our salvation. **Let us** come before His presence with thanksgiving; **Let us** shout joyfully to Him with psalms.

**Isaiah 1:18** “Come now, and **let us** reason together,” Says the Lord, “Though your sins are like scarlet, They shall be as white as snow; Though they are red like crimson, They shall be as wool.

**Isaiah 43:26** Put Me in remembrance; **Let us** contend together; State your case, that you may be acquitted.

**Isaiah 50:8** He is near who justifies Me; Who will contend with Me? **Let us** stand together. Who is My adversary? Let him come near Me.

**Jeremiah 50:5** They shall ask the way to Zion, With their faces toward it, saying, ‘Come and **let us** join ourselves to the Lord In a perpetual covenant That will not be forgotten.’

**Lamentations 3:40-41** **Let us** search out and examine our ways, And turn back to the Lord; **Let us** lift our hearts and hands To God in heaven.

**Hosea 6:1** Come, and **let us** return to the Lord; For He has torn, but He will heal us; He has stricken, but He will bind us up.

**Romans 12:6-7** Having then gifts differing according to the grace that is given to us, **let us** use them: if prophecy, **let us** prophesy in proportion to our faith; or ministry, **let us** use it in our ministering; he who teaches, in teaching;

**Romans 14:19** Therefore **let us** pursue the things which make for peace and the things by which one may edify another.

**Galatians 5:25** If we live in the Spirit, **let us** also walk in the Spirit.

**Galatians 6:9** And **let us** not grow weary while doing good, for in due season we shall reap if we do not lose heart.

**Philippians 3:15** Therefore **let us**, as many as are mature, have this mind; and if in anything you think otherwise, God will reveal even this to you.
