#### **Our Part**

- 1. Draw near...Just as we are
- 2. Faith

- Revelation 3:20 Behold, I stand at the door and knock. If anyone hears My voice and opens the
  door, I will come in to him and dine with him, and he with Me.
- o James 4:8 TPT Move your heart closer and closer to God, and he will come even closer to you.

# 2. Let us hold fast (Hebrews 10:23)

- Deuteronomy 10:20 You shall fear the Lord your God; you shall serve Him, and to Him you shall hold fast, and take oaths in His name.
- **Revelation 3:11** Behold, I am coming quickly! <u>Hold fast</u> what you have, that no one may take your crown.

# Confession...

## ...Of Sin

- o **Psalm 32:5** I acknowledged my sin to You, And my iniquity I have not hidden. I said, "I will confess my transgressions to the Lord," And You forgave the iniquity of my sin. *Selah*
- **Proverbs 28:13** He who covers his sins will not prosper, But whoever confesses and forsakes *them* will have mercy.
- o **1 John 1:9** If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.
- James 5:16 Confess your trespasses to one another, and pray for one another, that you may be healed. The effective, fervent prayer of a righteous man avails much.

#### ...Of Jesus

- Matthew 10:32 "Therefore whoever confesses Me before men, him I will also confess before My Father who is in heaven.
- Romans 10:9 that if you confess with your mouth the Lord Jesus and believe in your heart that God has raised Him from the dead, you will be saved.

- o **Romans 15:9** and that the Gentiles might glorify God for *His* mercy, as it is written: "For this reason I will confess to You among the Gentiles, And sing to Your name."
- o 1 John 4:15 Whoever confesses that Jesus is the Son of God, God abides in him, and he in God.

### He who promised is faithful!

- Isaiah 49:7 Thus says the Lord, the Redeemer of Israel, their Holy One, to Him whom man despises, to Him whom the nation abhors, to the Servant of rulers: "Kings shall see and arise, princes also shall worship, because of the Lord who is faithful, the Holy One of Israel; And He has chosen You."
- 1 Corinthians 1:9 God is faithful, by whom you were called into the fellowship of His Son, Jesus Christ our Lord.
- o **1 Thessalonians 5:24** He who calls you *is* faithful, who also will do *it*.
