### **1. Let us draw near (Hebrews 10:22)**

- **Revelation 3:20** Behold, I stand at the door and knock. If anyone hears My voice and opens the door, I will come in to him and dine with him, and he with Me.
  - **James 4:8 TPT** Move your heart closer and closer to God, and he will come even closer to you.

### **2. Let us hold fast (Hebrews 10:23)**

- **Deuteronomy 10:20** You shall fear the Lord your God; you shall serve Him, and to Him you shall hold fast, and take oaths in His name.
- **Revelation 3:11** Behold, I am coming quickly! Hold fast what you have, that no one may take your crown.

### **Confession...**

...Of Sin

- **Psalms 32:5** I acknowledged my sin to You, And my iniquity I have not hidden. I said, "I will confess my transgressions to the Lord," And You forgave the iniquity of my sin. *Selah*
- **Proverbs 28:13** He who covers his sins will not prosper, But whoever confesses and forsakes *them* will have mercy.
- **1 John 1:9** If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.
- **James 5:16** Confess your trespasses to one another, and pray for one another, that you may be healed. The effective, fervent prayer of a righteous man avails much.

...Of Jesus

- **Matthew 10:32** "Therefore whoever confesses Me before men, him I will also confess before My Father who is in heaven.
- **Romans 10:9** that if you confess with your mouth the Lord Jesus and believe in your heart that God has raised Him from the dead, you will be saved.

- **Romans 15:9** and that the Gentiles might glorify God for *His* mercy, as it is written: “For this reason I will confess to You among the Gentiles, And sing to Your name.”
- **1 John 4:15** Whoever confesses that Jesus is the Son of God, God abides in him, and he in God.

***He who promised is faithful!***

- **Isaiah 49:7** Thus says the Lord, the Redeemer of Israel, their Holy One, to Him whom man despises, to Him whom the nation abhors, to the Servant of rulers: “Kings shall see and arise, princes also shall worship, because of the Lord who is faithful, the Holy One of Israel; And He has chosen You.”
  - **1 Corinthians 1:9** God *is* faithful, by whom you were called into the fellowship of His Son, Jesus Christ our Lord.
  - **1 Thessalonians 5:24** He who calls you *is* faithful, who also will do *it*.

3. Tell how God used someone to encourage you this week
