"Mount Zion is not a literal mountain but an obvious metaphor for the realm of God's manifest presence. Mount Zion was once a Jebusite stronghold conquered by David (2 Samuel 5:6-9) who made it the capital for his kingdom. This is inside the walls of present day Jerusalem. Zion is used in both the Old Testament and the New Testament as more than a location. Zion is referred to as the place of God's dwelling (Psalm 9:11, 48:1-2, 74:2, Isaiah 8:18). God's people are called "Daughters of Zion" (Song 3:11, Zechariah 9:9, John 12:15). Zion is the heavenly realm where God is manifest (Psalm 84:7, 102:16, 110:1-2, Revelation 14:1)." Mount Zion

Psalm 48:1-2 Great is the Lord, and greatly to be praised in the city of our God, in His holy mountain. Beautiful in elevation, the joy of the whole earth, is Mount Zion on the sides of the north, the city of the great King.

Psalm 74:2 Remember Your congregation, which You have purchased of old, the tribe of Your inheritance, which You have redeemed— This Mount Zion where You have dwelt.

Psalm 125:1 Those who trust in the Lord are like Mount Zion, which cannot be moved, but abides forever.

Psalm 133:3 It is like the dew of Hermon, descending upon the mountains of Zion; For there the Lord commanded the blessing— Life forevermore.

Isaiah 2:3 Many people shall come and say, "Come, and let us go up to the mountain of the Lord, to the house of the God of Jacob; He will teach us His ways, and we shall walk in His paths." For out of Zion shall go forth the law, and the word of the Lord from Jerusalem.

Isaiah 8:18 Here am I and the children whom the Lord has given me! We are for signs and wonders in Israel From the Lord of hosts, who dwells in Mount Zion.

Isaiah 18:7 In that time a present will be brought to the Lord of hosts from a people tall and smooth of skin, and from a people terrible from their beginning onward, a nation powerful and treading down, whose land the rivers divide— To the place of the name of the Lord of hosts, to Mount Zion.

Isaiah 24:23 Then the moon will be disgraced and the sun ashamed; For the Lord of hosts will reign on Mount Zion and in Jerusalem and before His elders, gloriously.

Joel 2:32 And it shall come to pass that whoever calls on the name of the Lord shall be saved. For in Mount Zion and in Jerusalem there shall be deliverance, as the Lord has said, among the remnant whom the Lord calls.

Joel 3:17 "So you shall know that I am the Lord your God, dwelling in Zion my holy mountain. Then Jerusalem shall be holy, and no aliens shall ever pass through her again."

Revelation 14:1 Then I looked, and behold, a Lamb standing on Mount Zion, and with Him one hundred and forty-four thousand, having His Father's name written on their foreheads.

And those who dwell on the earth will marvel, whose names are not written in the Book of Life from the foundation of the world, when they see the beast that was, and is not, and yet is.
