## The Early Years - Hebrews 11:23

Acts 7:17-20 "But when the time of the promise drew near which God had sworn to Abraham, the people grew and multiplied in Egypt till another king arose who did not know Joseph. This man dealt treacherously with our people, and oppressed our forefathers, making them expose their babies, so that they might not live. At this time Moses was born, and <u>was well pleasing to God</u>; and he was brought up in his father's house for three months.

## The Rebellious Years - Hebrews 11:24-25

- Acts 7:21-22 But when he was set out, Pharaoh's daughter took him away and brought him up as her own son. And Moses was learned in all the wisdom of the Egyptians, and was mighty in words and deeds.
- Psalm 113:4-8The Lord is high above all nations, His glory above the heavens. Who is like the Lord our God, who dwells on high, who humbles Himself to behold the things that are in the heavens and in the earth? He raises the poor out of the dust, and <u>lifts the</u> <u>needy out of the ash heap, that He may seat him with princes</u>— With the princes of His people.

## The Glory Years - Hebrews 11:26-27

- 1 Peter 4:12-16 Beloved, do not think it strange concerning the fiery trial which is to try you, as though some strange thing happened to you; but rejoice to the extent that you partake of Christ's sufferings, that when His glory is revealed, you may also be glad with exceeding joy. If you are reproached for the name of Christ, blessed are you, for the Spirit of glory and of God rests upon you. On their part He is blasphemed, but on your part He is glorified. But let none of you suffer as a murderer, a thief, an evildoer, or as a busybody in other people's matters. Yet if anyone suffers as a Christian, let him not be ashamed, but let him glorify God in this matter.
- Philippians 3:7 TPT Yet all of the accomplishments that I once took credit for, I've now forsaken them and I regard it all as nothing compared to the delight of experiencing Jesus Christ as my Lord!
- 1 Timothy 6:17 Command those who are rich in this present age not to be haughty, nor to trust in uncertain riches <u>but in the living God</u>, who gives us richly all things to enjoy.
- 2 Corinthians 4:18 while we do not look at the things which are seen, but at the things which are not seen. For the things which are seen are temporary, but the things which are not seen are eternal.
- Colossians 1:15 He (Jesus) is the image of the invisible God...
