- 1:1 God speaks to us through Jesus
- 2:9 We see Jesus...And He tasted death for everyone
- 2:11 He calls us His brothers and sisters
- 2:14 He took on flesh and destroyed the devil
- 2:15 He released those who were in bondage to the fear of death
- 2:16 He gives aid to His people
- 2:17 He was made like us in ALL things and paid for our sins
- 2:18 As He was tempted, He is able to help us as we face those same temptations
- 3:1 We can *consider* (discover) Jesus
- 3:12 We have access to the Living God
- 3:14 We are partakers of Christ
- 4:1-11 We have access to His rest
- 4:12 He knows the thoughts and intentions of our hearts
- 4:13 Nothing is hidden from Him
- 4:15 He can attune perfectly to our weakness because He was in all points tempted as we are, and He did it without sin
- 4:16 We can approach the throne of grace with confidence to obtain mercy, find grace and help
- 5:9 He is the author of eternal salvation for all who would believe
- 6:10 God remembers our work of ministry to the saints
- 6:19 We have hope as an anchor to our soul
- 7:19 We have a better hope by which we draw near to God
- 7:22 Jesus is the surety of a better covenant for us
- 7:25 He is able to save to the uttermost all who would come to God through Him
- 7:25b He lives to make intercession for us
- 7:27 He offered Himself once for all
- 8:1 We have this High Priest who is seated at the right hand of the Father
- 8:3, 6 He has something to offer to us: A more excellent ministry, a better covenant and better promises
- 8:10 His laws are in our minds and written on our hearts
- 8:11 He is knowable
- 8:12 He no longer remembers our sins
- 9:11 He is the High Priest of the good things to come
- 9:12 He entered the Most Holy Place once for all and obtained eternal redemption
- 9:14 His blood was shed as He offered Himself without spot to God, and our consciences are cleansed from dead works and turned towards the Living God
- 9:15 We have the promise of the eternal inheritance
- 9:24 He entered into heaven itself to appear in the presence of God *for us*
- 9:28 He was offered once to bear the sins of many
- 9:28b He will appear a second time to save us
- 10:10 Jesus obeyed God's will in order to sanctify us through His body offered once for all
- 10:14 By this one offering He has perfected us forever
- 10:19-20 We have boldness to enter God's presence by the blood of Jesus
- 10:22 We can draw near to God with a genuine, pure heart in full assurance of faith
