When I Consider...

Websters: To think about carefully. To take into account. To gaze on steadily or reflectively. To study. To weigh. Implies sustained purposeful concentration and attention to details and minutiae. To contemplate. Stresses focusing one's thoughts on something but does not imply coming to a conclusion or decision

Psalm 8:3-4 When I **consider** Your heavens, the work of Your fingers, the moon and the stars, which You have ordained, what is man that You are mindful of him, and the son of man that You visit him? **1 Samuel 12:24** Only fear the Lord, and serve Him in truth with all your heart; for **consider** what great things He has done for you.

Job 37:14 Listen to this, O Job; Stand still and consider the wondrous works of God.

Ecclesiastes 7:13 Consider the work of God; For who can make straight what He has made crooked? **Romans 11:22** Therefore **consider** the goodness and severity of God: on those who fell, severity; but toward you, goodness, if you continue in His goodness. Otherwise you also will be cut off.

Websters: Moved by beauty. Amazement and astonishment

Wonder

Websters: A feeling of surprise mingled with admiration, caused by something beautiful, unexpected, unfamiliar, or inexplicable. A feeling caused by seeing something that is very surprising, beautiful, amazing, etc. It stokes curiosity; Exciting amazement; Far beyond anything previously known or anticipated

Acts 3:10 Then they knew that it was he who sat begging alms at the Beautiful Gate of the temple; and they were <u>filled with wonder and amazement</u> at what had happened to him.

Acts 10:17 Now while <u>Peter wondered within himself</u> what this vision which he had seen meant, behold, the men who had been sent from Cornelius had made inquiry for Simon's house, and stood before the gate.

Intentional Awe - From The Passion Translation

Psalm 2:11 Serve and worship the awe-inspiring God. Recognize his greatness and bow before him, trembling with reverence in his presence.

Psalm 4:4 Tremble in awe before the Lord, and do not sin against him. Be still upon your bed and search your heart before him. Pause in his presence

Psalm 5:7 But I know that you will welcome me into your house, for I am covered by your covenant of mercy and love. So I come to your sanctuary with deepest awe to bow in worship and adore you.

Psalm 27:4 Here's the one thing I crave from Yahweh, the one thing I seek above all else: I want to live with him every moment in his house, beholding the marvelous beauty of Yahweh, filled with awe, delighting in his glory and grace. I want to contemplate in his temple.

Psalm 29:2 Be in awe before his majesty. Be in awe before such power and might! Come worship wonderful Yahweh, arrayed in all his splendor, bowing in worship as he appears in the beauty of holiness. Give him the honor due his name. Worship him wearing the glory-garments of your holy, priestly calling!

Psalm 33:8 With breathtaking wonder, let everyone worship Yahweh, this awe-inspiring Creator.

Psalm 34:9 Worship in awe and wonder, all you who've been made holy! For all who fear him will feast with plenty.

Psalm 40:3 A new song for a new day rises up in me every time I think about how he breaks through for me! Ecstatic praise pours out of my mouth until everyone hears how God has set me free. Many will see his miracles; they'll stand in awe of God and fall in love with him!

Psalm 45:4 In your glory and grandeur go forth in victory! Through your faithfulness and meekness the cause of truth and justice will stand. Awe-inspiring miracles are accomplished by your power, leaving everyone dazed and astonished!

Psalm 64:9 Then all will stand awestruck over what God has done, seeing how he vindicated the victims of these crimes.

Psalm 65:5 You answer our prayers with amazing wonders and with awe-inspiring displays of power. You are the righteous God who helps us like a father. Everyone everywhere looks to you, for you are the confidence of all the earth, even to the farthest islands of the sea.

Psalm 65:8 O God, to the farthest corners of the planet people will stand in awe, startled and stunned by your signs and wonders. Sunrise brilliance and sunset beauty both take turns singing their songs of joy to you.

Psalm 66:3 For he's the awe-inspiring God, great and glorious in power! We've never seen anything like him! Mighty in miracles, you cause your enemies to tremble. No wonder they all surrender and bow before you!

Psalm 67:7 And the blessings keep coming! All the ends of the earth will give him the honor he deserves and be in awe of him!

Psalm 68:35 God, we are consumed with awe, trembling before you as your glory streams from your Holy Place. The God of power shares his mighty strength with Israel and with all his people. God, we give our highest praise to you!

Psalm 76:7-8 No wonder you are greatly feared! You are the awe-inspiring God! For who could ever stand before your face when your fierce anger burns and live to tell about it. As the earth itself holds its breath in awe before you, judgment is decreed from heaven.

Psalm 96:4 For the Lord's greatness is beyond description, and he deserves all the praise that comes to him. He is our King-God, and it's right to be in holy awe of him.

Psalm 96:6 Breathtaking brilliance and awe-inspiring majesty radiate from his shining presence. His stunning beauty overwhelms all who come before him.

Psalm 96:9 Come worship the Lord God wearing the splendor of holiness. Let everyone wait in wonder as they tremble in awe before him.

Psalm 99:1 Yahweh is King over all! Everyone trembles in awe before him. He rules enthroned between the wings of the cherubim. So let the earth shake and quake in wonder before him!

Psalm 103:13 The same way a loving father feels toward his children— that's but a sample of your tender feelings toward us, your beloved children, who live in awe of you.

Psalm 103:17 But Lord, your endless love stretches from one eternity to the other, unbroken and unrelenting toward those who fear you and those who bow facedown in awe before you. Your faithfulness to keep every gracious promise you've made passes from parents, to children, to grandchildren, and beyond.

Psalm 119:120 My body trembles in holy awe of you, leaving me speechless

Proverbs 9:10 The starting point for acquiring wisdom is to be consumed with awe as you worship Yahweh. To receive the revelation of the Holy One, you must come to the one who has living-understanding.

Proverbs 10:27 Living in the worship and awe of God will bring you many years of contented living. So how could the wicked ever expect to have a long, happy life?

Proverbs 14:26-27 Confidence and strength flood the hearts of the lovers of God who live in awe of him, and their devotion provides their children with a place of shelter and security. To worship God in wonder and awe opens a fountain of life within you, empowering you to escape death's domain.

Proverbs 15:16 It's much better to live simply, surrounded in holy awe and worship of God, than to have great wealth with a home full of trouble.

Proverbs 19:23 When you live a life of abandoned love, surrendered before the awe of God, here's what you'll experience: Abundant life. Continual protection. And complete satisfaction!

Proverbs 23:17 Don't allow the actions of evil men to cause you to burn with anger. Instead, burn with unrelenting passion as you worship God in holy awe.

Proverbs 31:30 Charm can be misleading, and beauty is vain and so quickly fades, but this virtuous woman lives in the wonder, awe, and fear of the Lord. She will be praised throughout eternity.

Isaiah 8:13 Fear nothing and no one except Yahweh, Commander of Angel Armies! Honor him as holy. Be in awe before him with deepest reverence!

Isaiah 30:30 And Yahweh will cause everyone to hear his awe-inspiring, majestic voice. He will open their eyes to see his mighty power coming down with raging anger and consuming fire! His power will descend in cloudburst, thunderstorm, and hail.

Isaiah 66:2 "My hand made these things so they all belong to me," declares Yahweh. "But there is one my eyes are drawn to: the humble one, the tender one, the trembling one who lives in awe of all I say."

Matthew 7:28 By the time Jesus finished speaking, the crowds were awestruck by his teaching

Matthew 9:8 When the crowds witnessed this miracle, they were awestruck. They shouted praises to God because he had given such authority to human beings.

Mark 1:22 The people were awestruck by his teaching, because he taught in a way that demonstrated God's authority, which was quite unlike the religious scholars.

Mark 4:41 But they were overwhelmed with fear and awe and said to one another, "Who is this man who has such authority that even the wind and waves obey him?"

Luke 2:47 All who heard Jesus speak were awestruck at his intelligent understanding of all that was being discussed and at his wise answers to their questions.

Luke 4:22 Everyone was impressed by how well Jesus spoke, in awe of the beautiful words of grace that came from his lips. But they said among themselves, "Who does he think he is? Isn't he Joseph's son, who grew up here in Nazareth?"

Luke 5:9-10 Simon Peter and the other fishermen—including his fishing partners, Jacob and John, the sons of Zebedee—were awestruck over the miracle catch of fish. Jesus answered, "Do not yield to your fear, Simon Peter. From now on, you will catch men for salvation!"

Luke 9:36 When the thunderous voice faded away and the cloud disappeared, Jesus was standing there alone. Peter, Jacob, and John were awestruck. But they didn't say a word to anyone about what they had seen.

Luke 9:43 Everyone was awestruck and stunned to see such power and the majesty of God flow through Jesus.

Luke 19:48 They could find no reason to accuse him, for he was a hero to the people and the crowds were awestruck by every word he spoke.

Luke 23:47 When the Roman captain overseeing the crucifixion witnessed all that took place, he was awestruck and glorified God. Acknowledging what they had done, he said, "I have no doubt; we just killed the righteous one."

Acts 2:43 A deep sense of holy awe swept over everyone, and the apostles performed many miraculous signs and wonders.

Acts 9:31 After this, the church all over Judea, Galilee, and Samaria experienced a season of peace. The congregations grew larger and larger, with the believers being empowered and encouraged by the Holy Spirit. They worshiped God in wonder and awe, and walked in the fear of the Lord.

2 Corinthians 5:11 Since we are those who stand in holy awe of the Lord, we make it our passion to persuade others to turn to him. We know that our lives are transparent before the God who knows us fully, and I hope that we are also well known to your consciences.

Ephesians 3:14 So I kneel humbly in awe before the Father of our Lord Jesus, the Messiah **Colossians 3:22b** For we are to live our lives with pure hearts in the constant awe and wonder of our Lord God.

1 Timothy 6:6 We have a "profit" that is greater than theirs—our holy awe of God! To have merely our necessities is to have enough.

Hebrews 12:28 Since we are receiving our rights to an unshakable kingdom we should be extremely thankful and offer God the purest worship that delights his heart as we lay down our lives in absolute surrender, filled with awe.

1 Peter 1:17 Since you call on him as your heavenly Father, the impartial Judge who judges according to each one's works, live each day with holy awe and reverence throughout your time on earth. **Revelation 15:4** Who will not reverence you with awe, O Lord, and bring glory to your name? For you alone are holy, and all nations will come and bow in worship before you, as your blessings have revealed.
